METHODOLOGY

These surveys were conducted on the Newspoll Telephone Omnibus during the period 6-8 & 13-15 December 2013 by trained interviewers in Victoria in both city and country areas. Telephone numbers and the person within the household were selected at random. The data have been weighted to reflect the population distribution. The survey is based on 600 interviews among Victorians aged 18 years and over. The maximum expected margin of sampling error on the total is plus or minus 4 percentage points.
