Are you being paid correctly for your holidays?

"Your rate of holiday pay may increase or decrease throughout the holiday year depending on premium hours worked by you and your contractual basic hourly rate during the 12 weeks prior to your holiday. Your holiday rate will never be less than your contractual rate of pay. If you are in receipt of a weekly 'Top Rate supplement' this will be reflected in your holiday pay."

What this means is that your holiday pay should be based on the average of what your actual pay has been over the previous 12 weeks.

Example - you are contracted to 10 hours per week but have actually been working 20 hours per week for the last 12 weeks. Your holiday pay should then be paid at 20 hours and not your contracted 10 hours.

The GMB are able to support members in investigating whether you have been paid correctly and assist you in claiming back any monies owed. JOIN TODAY!

GMB helping with your Health and Safety issues

It is a fact that workplaces with a union present are safer places to work. GMB Health and Safety Reps are here to advise and resolve your health and safety issues in store. Your Representative receives training to enable them to perform risk assessments and deal with issues in your store.

A recent example in a Yorkshire store involved the produce deliveries. Totes were being stacked too high with heavy items being placed on top. Unloading these was obviously putting our members at risk of injury. The Rep at the store got involved with management to resolve the issue and put measures in place to prevent it from happening again.
