- How much polluted runoff does your congregation generate? Receive a free assessment to find out, and learn about potential projects to reduce your pollution.
- Under the guidance of your AAMWS, each congregation makes their own decisions about which projects to implement.
- Receive professionally designed and installed improvements to reduce polluted runoff including...
 - o Rain Gardens
 - Pervious Hardscapes
 - Conservation Landscapes with Native Plants

Congregations will be asked to underwrite a nominal portion of the project costs and agree to maintenance.

Installations will be made in the Fall of 2014 and Spring of 2015.
