

Calling for the City of Los Angeles to Fully License Cannabis Businesses

Whereas, despite being the second largest city in the United States and the largest cannabis market in the world, Los Angeles continues to be a confusing and unregulated jurisdiction, poorly serving voters and stakeholders; and

Whereas, an overwhelming 80% of LA voters approved Measure M, which authorizes a licensing, taxation and enforcement structure for cannabis businesses in Los Angeles, as 90 other cities across California already have; and

Whereas, no legitimate business in Los Angeles or California can function and grow without a business license:

Therefore be it resolved, the LACDP urges the Los Angeles City Council and Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti to implement full licensing for cannabis businesses in Los Angeles as promised by Measure M and as dictated by state law,

Therefore be it further resolved, the LACDP will send this resolution to the Los Angeles City Council, Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti, and City Attorney Mike Feuer.
