Thank you for letting me have this opportunity to provide written testimony regarding H.1742 pertaining to annual filing fees for certain businesses.

According to a CNBC study, Massachusetts currently ranks 47th in the nation for the cost of doing business. It also ranks 34th in the nation for corporate tax climate and 49th in the nation for unemployment insurance tax according to the Tax Foundation. Overall, this paints a picture of a state that is not only not trying to attract more businesses, it is doing what it can to keep them away, in turn keeping more jobs away.

H.1742 gives a small but needed break for LLC's as it waives the initial organization and annual filing fees, and reduces the annual report filing fee from \$500 to \$125. This reduction in fees will help promote small start-up businesses and make it easier on them by getting rid of one of many hurdles they must be set to overcome. On behalf of Massachusetts Fiscal Alliance, entrepreneurs and small business owners across the Commonwealth, we hope the Labor Committee will do everything they can to advance this commonsense proposal. It's long overdue.

For the first time in six years, it looks as though the jobless rate in Massachusetts will be higher than the national average of 7%. We must focus on creating a business friendly climate in the state in order to be the national leader in job creation.
