

# Terms & Conditions of Registration

## Photography/Video

Micah Challenge will be filming and photographing many aspects of the Voices for Justice conference for publicity purposes. By registering for Voices for Justice, you grant Micah Challenge permission to use any photos, videos or recording of you for media or promotional purposes.

## Communication

The contact details you have provided in your registration will be used by Micah Challenge to contact you in the lead up to, during and following the conference. Your contact details will not be shared with anyone else without your prior permission.

## Cancellation Policy

Cancellations before September 13th will attract a \$50 cancellation fee to cover administrative costs. After September 13th a cancellation fee of up to 50% of your full payment may apply depending on circumstances.

## Registration Confirmation

Conference registrations are not confirmed until payment has been received in full.

## Code of Conduct

As an ambassador for Micah Challenge and an advocate for the world's poor, you commit to the following code of conduct during Voices for Justice 2015:

1. At all times you will relate to other participants, to Parliamentarians and their staff with respect and courtesy.
2. You will enter the secure areas (those requiring passes for entry) of Australian Parliament House (APH) only:
  - a. To attend a formally scheduled meeting with an MP or Senator, or
  - b. To attend a scheduled event or forum organised by Micah Challenge that you have signed up for (because of venue space limitations), or
  - c. At the express direction of a Micah Challenge staff person
3. You will follow all reasonable directions of Micah Challenge staff and organisers, as well as APH security and staff whilst visiting Parliament House.
