

We Deserve Clean Elections!

Help make sure the special senate election being held in New Haven and West Haven on February 25th has real integrity. Recent articles in local news organizations show there is a real reason for electors to be concerned that their vote counts, and that corruption could be at play.

IF YOU SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING.

On election day, and even in advance of February 25th, if you see something that you believe undermines the election process, or is possible evidence of real corruption or criminal activity, say something by calling the **BALLOT INTEGRITY HOTLINE** at **203-427-8244**. You should also call the Secretary of State at **860-509-6200**. The Secretary of State's job is to ensure that the voting process is legal.

Here are some basic violations of campaign and election laws that should prompt you to call:

- You see that people are being **PAID** to vote for a certain candidate.
- You see that someone is voting using the **STOLEN IDENTITY** of another person, including someone who is dead.
- You see someone voting **MULTIPLE TIMES**.
- You see that an **IMPROPER** absentee ballot has been cast, or that someone has made a **FALSE STATEMENT** related to an absentee ballot.
- You see **UNAUTHORIZED HANDLING**, transporting, or filling out absentee ballots

These are among some of the serious election-related crimes which Connecticut law considers to be felonies, punishable by imprisonment and fines.

America is a nation of laws, ruled by the **consent of the governed**. That consent is derived from clean elections, free from corruption, with guaranteed integrity. Don't let criminals diminish your vote or our state. Remember, **IF YOU SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING ...**
