



## Florida Survey Results

**Q1** How likely would you say you are to vote in the elections in the fall of 2014? Are you certain to vote, will you probably vote, are the chances fifty-fifty, or will you probably not vote?

<i>Certain to vote</i> .....	93%
<i>Will probably vote</i> .....	7%
<i>Chances are 50-50</i> .....	0%
<i>Will probably not vote</i> .....	0%
<i>Not sure</i> .....	0%

**Q2** Would you support or oppose a law that would ensure employees have the right to earn a set number of sick days that would allow them to take time off when they are sick or need to take care of a family member -- without being fired or losing a day's wages?

<i>Strongly support</i> .....	65%
<i>Somewhat support</i> .....	15%
<i>Don't support at all</i> .....	16%
<i>Not sure</i> .....	4%

**Q3** Do you support or oppose the "living wage" laws already in place in Florida that require businesses that have public contracts to pay wages above the federal poverty level, and sometimes benefits, to their workers?

**Q4** The Florida legislature is moving forward with a bill that would eliminate the right for local governments and voters to make their own laws. If passed, this law would take away the right of local communities to vote on things like earned sick time, a living wage, and wage theft laws, and make it impossible for communities to use tax dollars to try and create jobs. Do you support or oppose the right of local governments and voters to make their own laws?

**Q10** If you are 18 to 29 years old, press 1. If 30 to 45, press 2. If 46 to 65, press 3. If you are older than 65, press 4.

*18 to 45*..... 30%  
*46 to 65*..... 43%  
*Older than 65*..... 27%
