Get the facts about school choice.

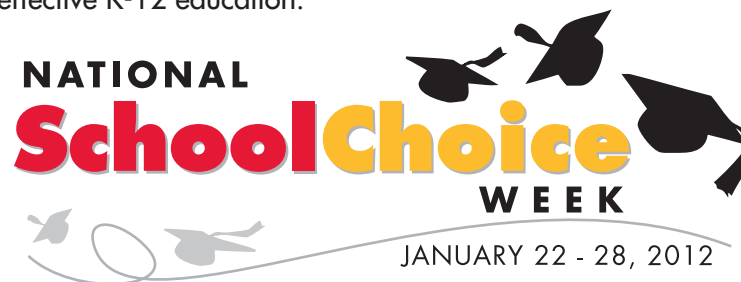
