


THE DISCOVERY

THE FILM





THE MOVEMENT

In Utero has already been translated into fifteen languages. It has sparked movements in the United States, Netherlands, Germany, Denmark, Australia and China. HEALING THE WOUNDS

***In Utero's* release has made it clear that there is a vast global need. Each day mothers birth 350,000 babies. That's 123 million babies a year.**

We have recently restructured our website to address this overwhelming need and we have started production on a follow-up film because we must move *beyond discovery to solutions*.

***In Utero 2*, when completed by late 2018, will be all about *solutions* - exploring epigenetic labs in Asia, birthing centers in South America, cutting-edge therapies across Europe and the U.S, shamanism in Africa and neurobiological work in Scandinavia. We will go wherever *solutions* exist. The stories of pregnant mothers will be followed along with the struggles of adult patients working to resolve their in utero trauma which increasingly appears to result in nearly all physiological and psychological illnesses.**

In Utero 2* will be a *powerful tapestry of emotional human stories about healing*, driven by the music, movies and culture of our time, which - when one digs deep - vibrates with our earliest dilemma - *how we begin is who we become!

We are also developing two reality TV shows that will expand our reach to the “small” screen and take advantage of the longer format to delve even deeper into the ever expanding knowledge around the impact of in utero development. *Making Modern Babies* will bring world-class experts to the daily joys and dramas of pregnant women. *Un-Crazy!* will follow a celebrity searching the world for adult therapies that genuinely heal. Both shows are represented by the Gersh Agency and Untitled Management.



BUILDING THE MOVEMENT

Driven by two movies, two TV shows and the social media that surrounds them, including our blogs on The Huffington Post, Thrive Global and other sites too numerous to mention - we will initiate political actions in tandem with other groups worldwide to expand funding for prenatal research, push for national family leave and work to address the consequences of trauma in the womb as it presents itself in children, adolescents and adults.

We need committed practitioners, volunteers and organizations to help. And we need money, which can be in the form of tax deductible contributions or investment.

IN UTERO PACKAGE FINANCIALS

We estimate the cost to be \$1.65 million to accomplish all of the following:

1. Make *In Utero 2* (\$800,000)

2. Develop the TV shows (\$175,000)

3. Maintain the infrastructure to service the demand for *In Utero 1 & 2*, build a team to service these projects, drive the critical information into the mainstream, invigorating prenatal, perinatal, adolescent and adult therapies across the globe (\$675,000 for three years)
