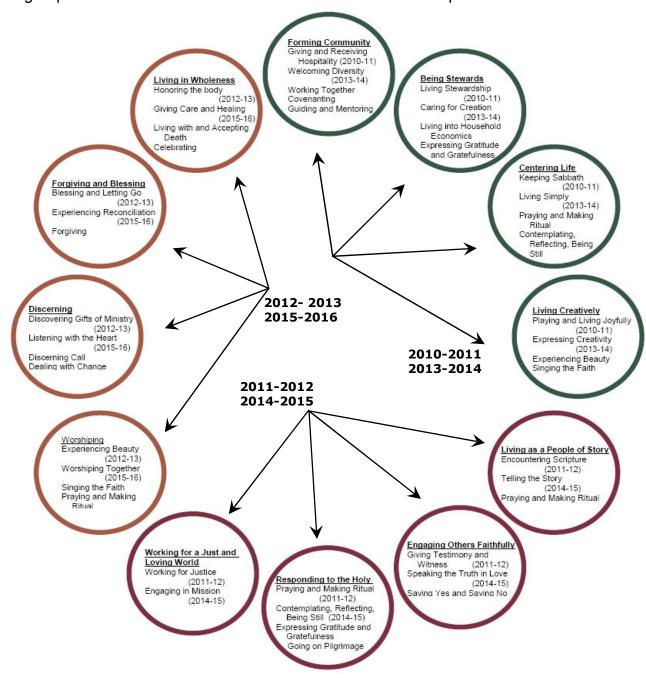


# Faith Practices: Worship, Learning, and Serving for Vital Congregations from The Pilgrim Press

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#### **Session Development**

Each week leaders may choose from 9 activities which help learners engage in practicing our faith, normally choosing at least one activity from Exploring and Engaging, Discerning and Deciding, and Sending and Serving. Three activities will lead a group in 30-45 minutes of learning and reflection.

Three activities in each exploration are designed for "easy preparation" (able to be done with minimal preparation with supplies normally found at the church).

One session:

30-45 minutes (Choose 3 activities)

45-60 minutes (Choose 4 or 5 activities)

Two sessions:

Using all 9 activities provides resources for two sessions of 45-60 minutes each. (Choose 4 or 5 activities each session)
