The story is poignant and inspirational, and includes a letter from Bill Johnson’s mother, interviews with Bill, young people and church leaders (clergy and lay), who either supported or opposed Bill’s candidacy.

This book chronicles a minister's attempts to expand the membership of a rapidly shrinking congregation in a poor, inner city Toronto neighborhood. When members decided to evangelize among the marginalized and "queer" at their gate, church members are radically changed. **Religion is a Queer Thing:  
A Guide to the Christian Faith for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgendered Persons**

*Elizabeth Stuart, John McMahon, Malcolm Edwards, Tim Morrison, and Andy Braunston*

This book makes queer theology available and accessible to a general audience and encourages the reader to become part of the ongoing development of this theology. It is a study guide which can be used by groups or individuals, and contains exercises and liturgies as well as explanations of queer theology. **\$16.**

### **Sacred Covenants, Faithful Conversations**

This DVD resource is for individuals, congregations, and others groups engaging in the study of marriage equality as called for in the General Synod 25 resolution, "In support of marriage equality for all."
