DECLARATION OF GRETCHEN SCHULTZ

Gretchen Schultz declares:

1. In 1989, when Billy the elephant currently on exhibit at the Los Angeles Zoo was first acquired, I was employed there. I vividly recall his arrival.

- 2. Each fact set forth in this declaration is known to me of my own personal knowledge. If called as a witness I could and would competently testify to each facts set forth herein.
- 3. When Billy arrived at the Zoo, with three female Asian elephants, he was young, less than full grown and extremely cute. I recall spending considerable time watching him. I have reviewed the declaration of Jeff Briscoe, representing that Billy exhibited head bobbing and weaving, similar to his current behavior, when he arrived. I do not recall any of these four elephants, including Billy, head bobbing when he arrived.
- 4. It is my clear recollection that Billy exhibited none of the "stereotypic" behavior he now exhibits on a daily basis.
- 5. Further, it is my recollection that Mr. Briscoe was not working in the elephant barn at that time. He later returned to the elephants. However, at the time that
