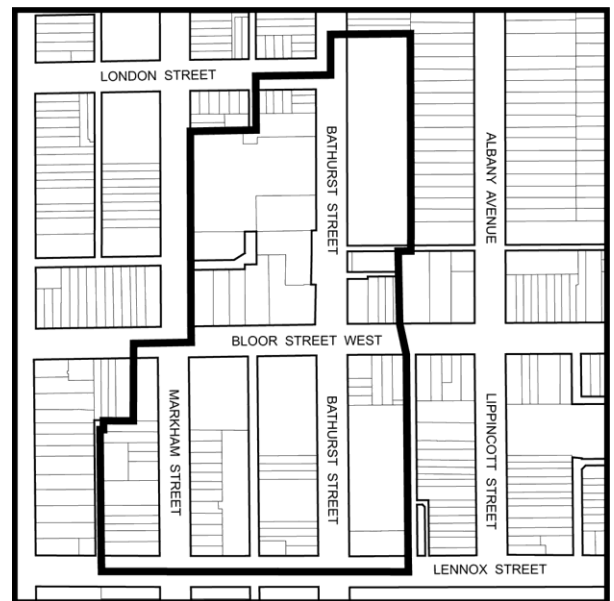
The City is holding a community consultation meeting to get your feedback on draft Official Plan policy for the study area.
