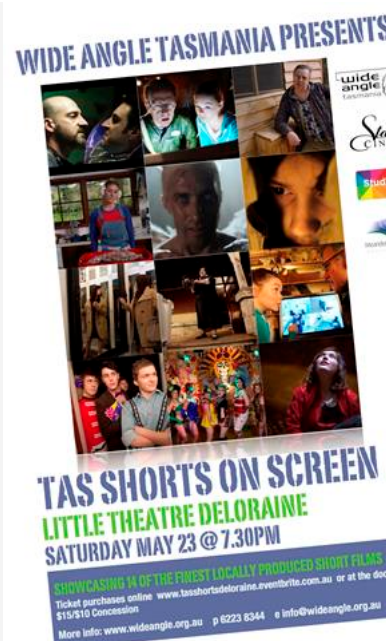

Actor/Director communication – 2 day masterclass with Di Drew

Sat May 30 & Sun May 31. Enrolments due May 10

This course is a fantastic opportunity for early-mid career screen practitioners and screen actors who are serious about entering the industry to gain valuable practical experience in director/actor communication. The Course Director and Tutor is Di Drew, Head of Television at the National Institute of Dramatic Art (NIDA) and one of Australia's most respected and award winning, drama directors and producers.



This intensive two-day workshop explores the process of actors and directors working together from casting to the shoot. The roles of the actor and director will be discussed and a range of communication skills will be demonstrated. Day 1 involves a half day of observing Di work – demonstrating the processes involved in directing professional actors, and observing how actors communicate with Di in the role of director. After establishing a shared language, participants will engage in practical sessions in which scenes, character and ideas are explored under Di's guidance. The sessions will be lit and filmed to enable students to gain a real understanding of how performance translates on screen.
