

### **34<sup>th</sup> District Meeting Minutes for December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015**

#### **New business:**

**Treasurer report from Myke Wilken:** current balance in our account is \$1899.41. We spend \$100/month for the American Legion rental space, and \$14/month for our bank account fee. We need to bring in more than \$114/month in order to sustain our budget in the long-term.

**Executive board update from KCGOP 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-Chair Courtney Lyle:** precinct caucus trainings are being conducted online for PCOs through KCGOP; please sign up for a training soon. Molly Connelly and Courtney Lyle will represent the 34thGOP to the KCGOP Communications Committee, and are working on increasing our social media activity and online presence. Consider creating a Facebook account to connect with the 34<sup>th</sup> and KCGOP online, and stay current with state and county legislative activity updates relayed through Facebook.

**Guest Speaker:** Mark Miloscia, State Senator for the 30<sup>th</sup> Legislative District. Sen. Miloscia spoke to his 2016 candidacy for State Auditor. We need a quality professional. Has audited colleges, non-profits, for-profits, and businesses. We need a watchdog on the governor, and on local government.

KCGOP Chair Lori Sotelo spoke, and emphasized the importance of participating in the online precinct caucus training.
