

34th District GOP Meeting Minutes for January 20th, 2016

Meeting called to order at 7:09PM by District Chair Chuck Rangel. Pledge of Allegiance led by District Chair Chuck Rangel.

December minutes presented, and approved.

Treasurer report from Myke Wilken: current balance in our account is \$1976.41. Gratitude to the Vashon Republicans and Bob Stewart for their recent generous donations.

Executive board update from KCGOP 2nd Vice Chair Courtney Lyle: precinct caucuses are coming up on Feb. 20th. Sign up for precinct caucus training at kcgop.org.

Newsletter report from Steve Schmidt: social media can significantly influence voters, let's work on expanding our social media presence.

Report from District Chair Chuck Rangel: we have volunteer needs for the pooled precinct caucus on 2/20. Volunteers should arrive by 8:30am. Volunteer needs: credentialing – we need computer literate volunteers to bring laptops and use building wifi to check voter registration at the event. Caucus attendees will need to show government issued photo ID, and then will have to prove they are a registered voter – this can be done by showing their voter registration card, and if they don't have their card, we will verify them through the King County Elections department website. Craig Keller is in charge of the West Seattle High School location, and Chuck Rangel is in charge of the Evergreen Campus location. We need a parliamentarian for each location. We need two Sergeant at Arms for each location. We need many volunteers to help with cleanup afterwards. PCO Portal at KCGOP.org has online precinct caucus training available for PCOs.
