# LD34 Goals and Objectives – A Starting Point

## Short term goals (6 months):

- Establish rules and format for monthly LD34 meetings to allow input, but try to keep short .
- Appoint 3 Regional chairs by Mid April. Have them begin regional meetings on issues.
- Implement above board and committees
- Have LD34 web page up and running
- Mesh district website with other social media by July '15
- Start fundraiser for Aug '15
- Relocate permanent meeting facility in West Seattle
- Increase visibility and presence by staffing booth at local fairs
- Increase PCOs in district by 25 new PCOs by October '15

## 2 Year Goals:

- Fill all PCO positions.
- Increase leadership support by attending Regional meetings
- Search for candidates with strong conservative values and mass appeal.
- Put anti-Agenda 21 person in Planning Commissions for regional cities
- Increase Republican turn out by 10% of 2012 levels
- Have LD34 web page hit count of 200 hits per month.
- Doorbell 25% of neighborhoods
- Recruit 100 new non-youth volunteers
- Recruit 100 youth volunteers
- Host more goofy counter campaigns on issues (i.e., turn in bananas)
- Retain conservative thinking (voting) city council members in Burien.

## 4 Year Goals:

- Find pro-conservative candidates for local school districts
- Find pro-conservative candidates for local city councils
- Get (1) Republican elected to state legislature from a West Side district
- Increase Republican turn out by 20% of 2012 levels
- Increase public LD34 precinct caucus by 25% in 2016
- Doorbell 75% of neighborhood
- Increase amount of volunteer time devoted to Republican candidates by 25%
- Have LD34 individual elected to King County Republican Board
