Short term goals (6 months): MUCH PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE ON ACHIEVING THESE GOALS

- Establish rules and format for monthly LD34 meetings to allow input, but try to keep short .

- Appoint 3 Regional chairs by Mid April. Have them begin regional meetings on issues. **UPDATE: We have 2 chairs. Still need White Center area chair.**
- Implement above board and committees **Update: Implemented.**
- Have LD34 web page up and running **Update: Implemented.**
- Mesh district website with other social media by July '15 **Update: Implemented.**
- Start fundraiser for Aug '15 **Update: Under discussion.**
- Relocate permanent meeting facility in West Seattle **Update: Implemented.**
- Increase visibility and presence by staffing booth at local fairs **Update: Implemented.**
- Increase PCOs in district by 25 new PCOs by October '15

2 Year Goals:

- Fill all PCO positions.
- Increase leadership support by attending Regional meetings

- Search for candidates with strong conservative values and mass appeal.

- Put anti-Agenda 21 person in Planning Commissions for regional cities
- Increase Republican turn out by 10% of 2012 levels
Update: Implemented. Attendance averaging 20 per month. Up from 10-12 range.
- Have LD34 web page hit count of 200 hits per month.
