In April 2015, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint Energy) notified you that it had filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas(PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN). The CCN application requested authorizationfor CenterPoint Energy to constructnew 345 kV transmission facilitieson your property.The CCN application was assigned to Docket No. 44547.

The PUC issued the Order in Docket No. 44547 on January 15, 2016, in which Alternative Route 1A Modified (SegmentsB,F, LA, I3, LD, N1A, K3, N1C, H2, V2A, L3, A3, C3, D3A, M3, O3, P3, Q3, and R3), was designated as the route along which CenterPoint Energy is authorized to construct the new transmission facilities. Your land is located along the approved route, and CenterPoint Energy may need to obtain additional land rights from you. Enclosed are a copy of the Order in Docket No. 44547, a map showing the approved route for the transmission facilities, and State of Texas Landowner’s Bill of Rights, which was prepared by the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas.
