There many exciting races this year. I was five years old when Jim McDermott was first elected to the U.S. House of Representatives. He won with 71% of the vote in 1988 and has been re-elected 11 times with no substantive opposition. 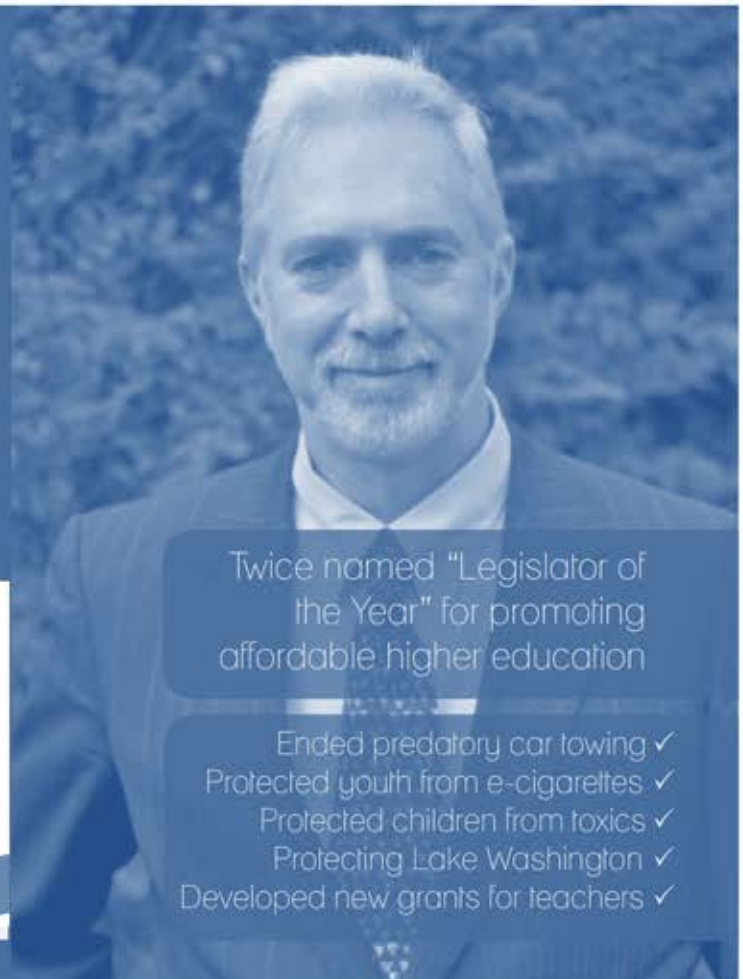
