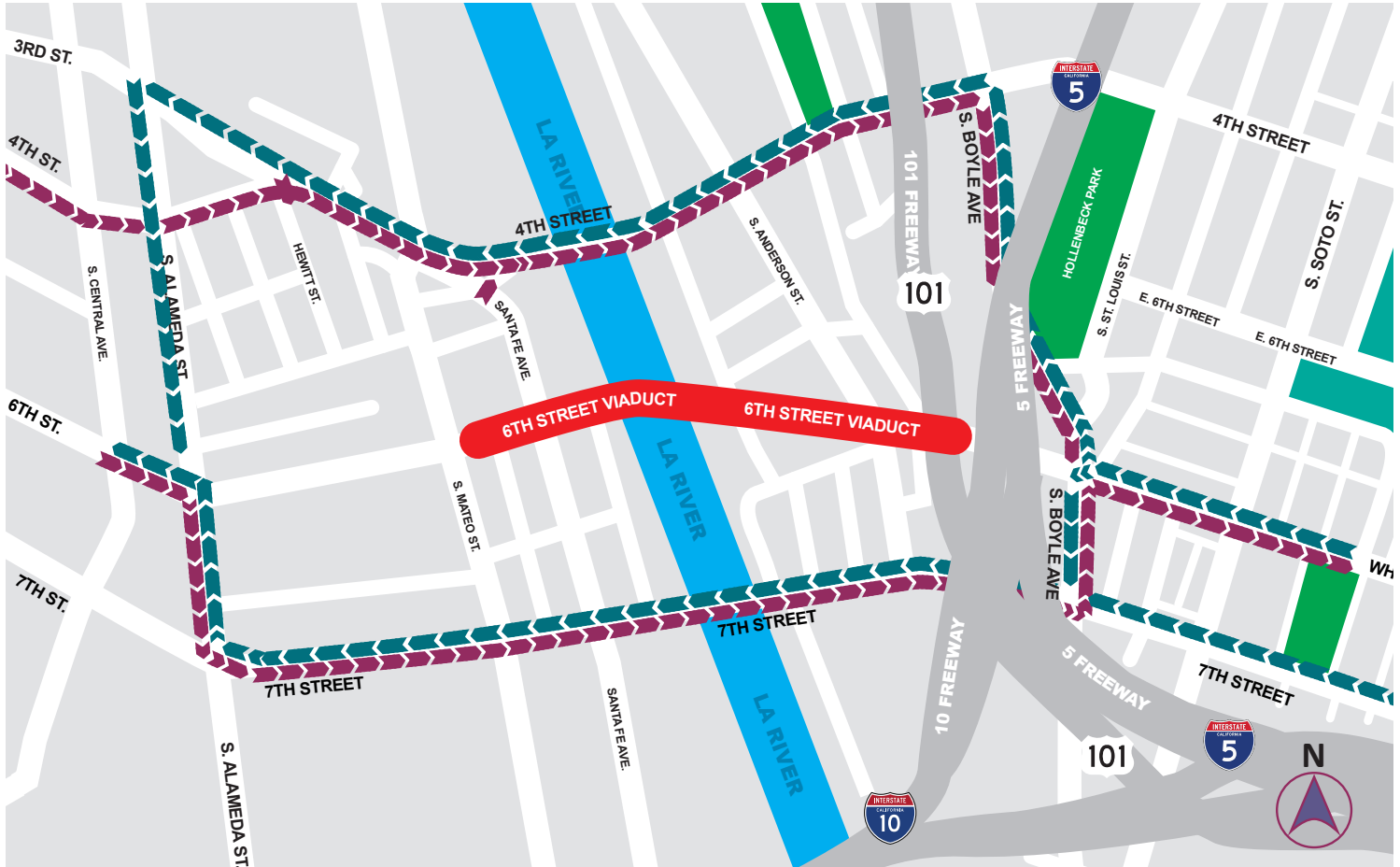


CITY OF LOS ANGELES SIXTH STREET VIADUCT PROJECT

- Westbound Whittier Boulevard will be detoured to 4th Street and 7th Street via Boyle Avenue (detour signs will be posted)
- Eastbound 6th Street will be detoured to 4th Street and 7th Street via Alameda Street (detour signs will be posted)

THE SIXTH STREET VIADUCT REPLACEMENT PROJECT will replace the existing, 3500-foot long viaduct with a structure that provides safer traffic and goods movement and incorporates exceptional bike and pedestrian access, twelve acres of open and recreational space and public art elements. The \$482 million project is being led by the Bureau of Engineering and is the largest bridge project in the history of Los Angeles.
