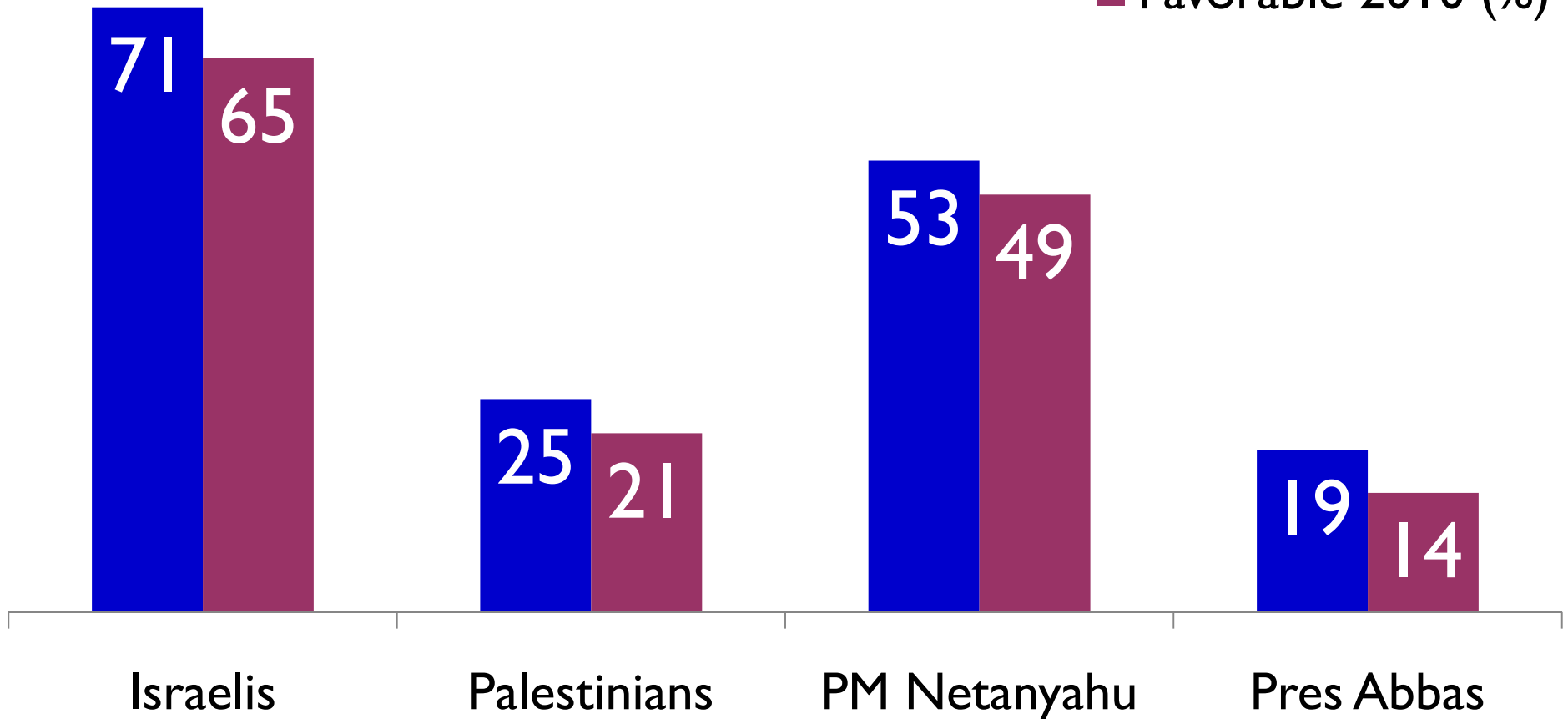

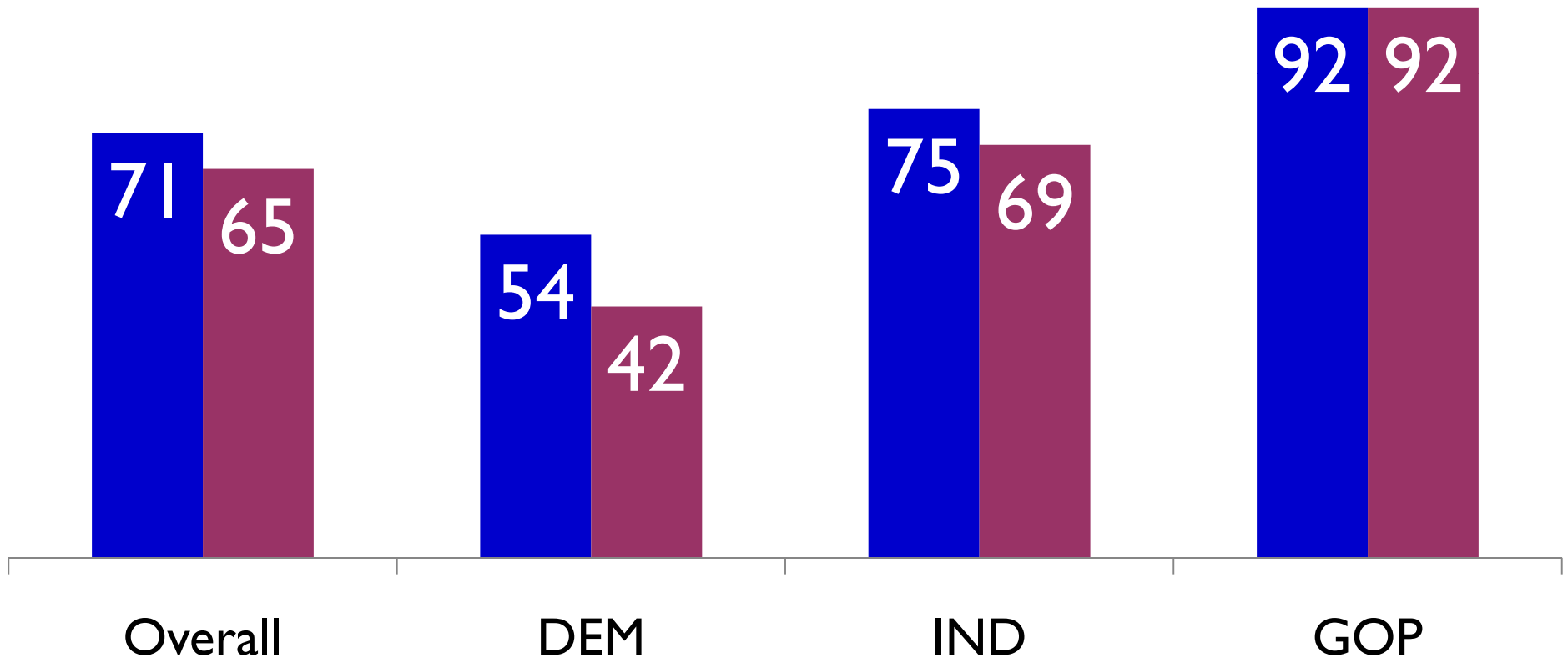

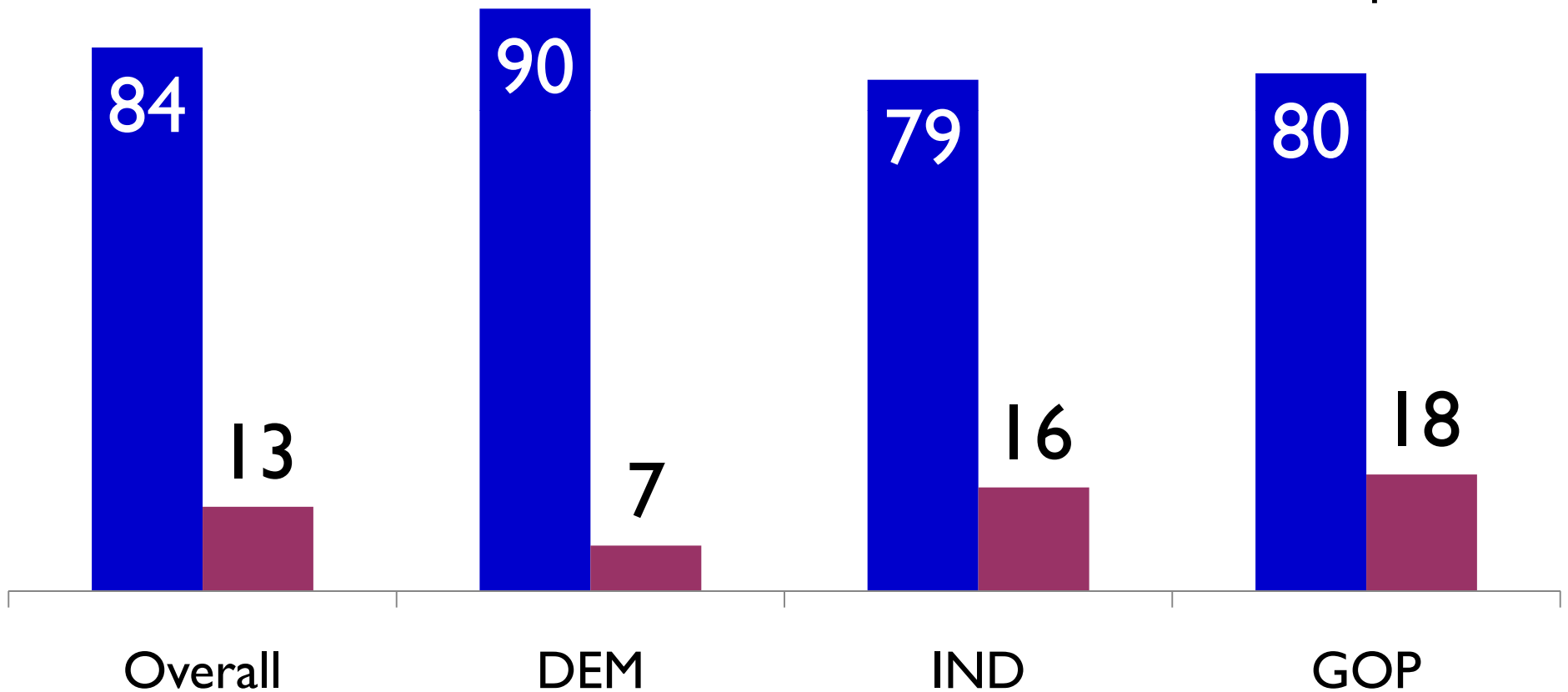

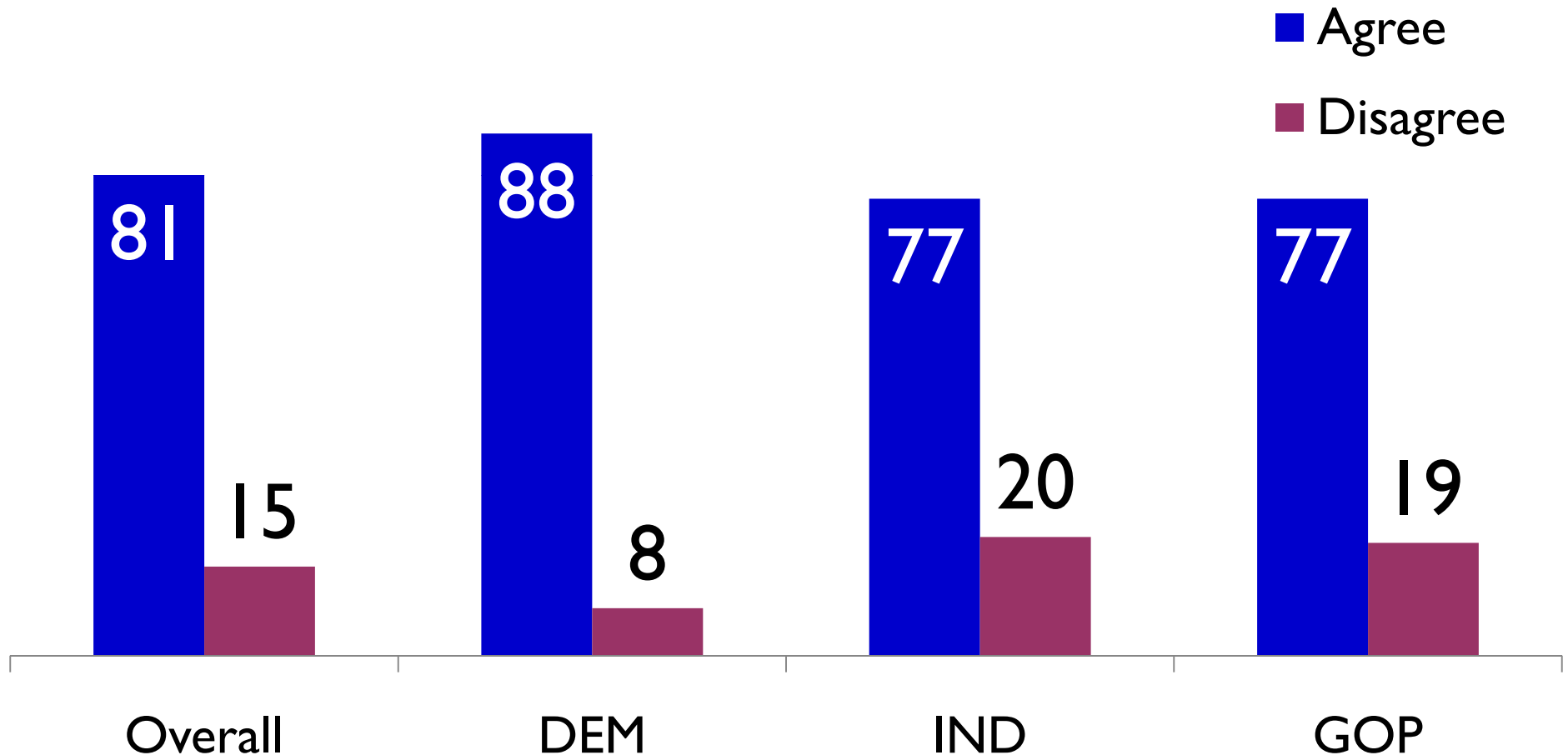
Resolution of Conflict is Important

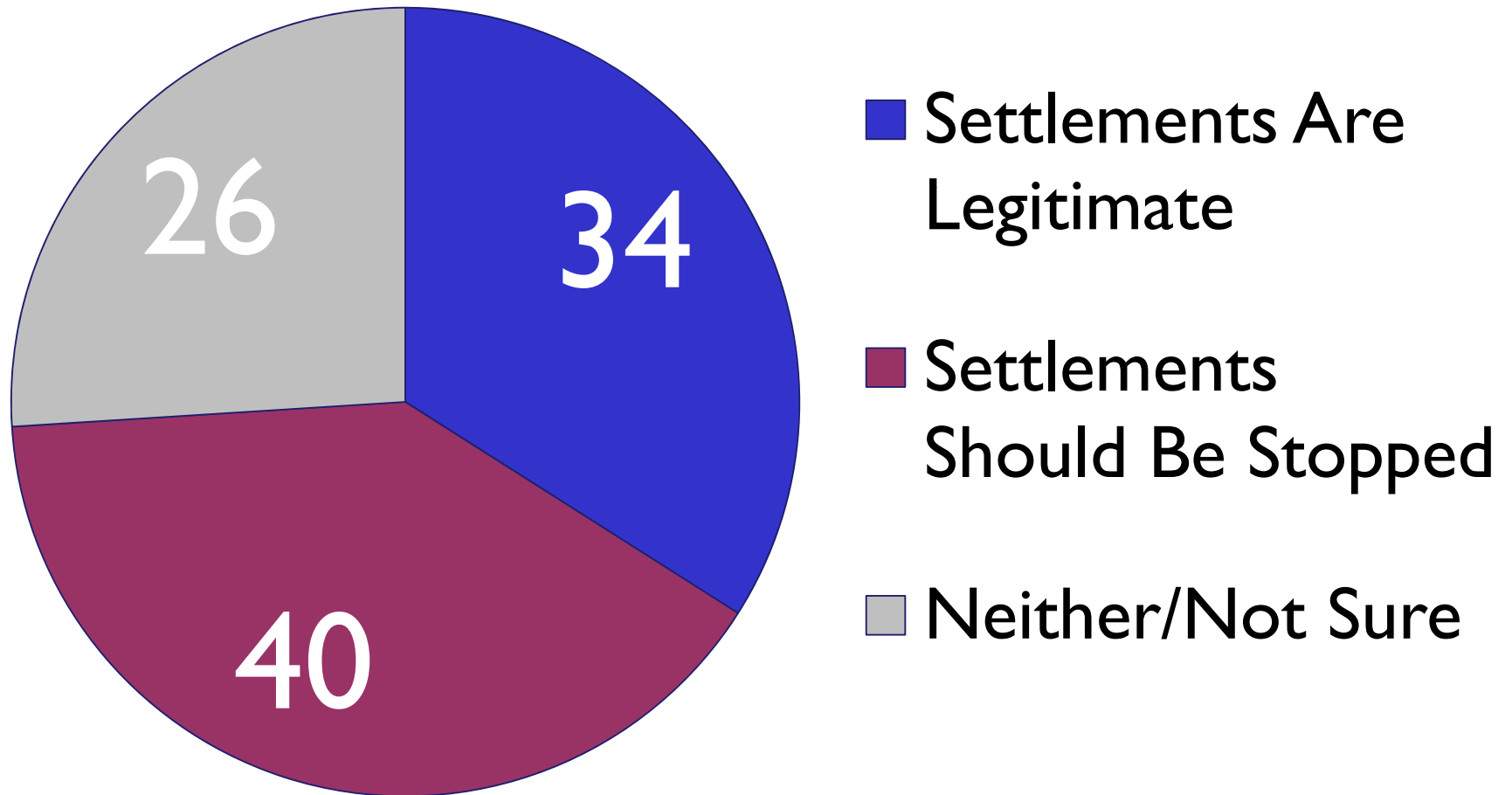

Conflict Has Negative Impact on U.S. Interests in Middle East



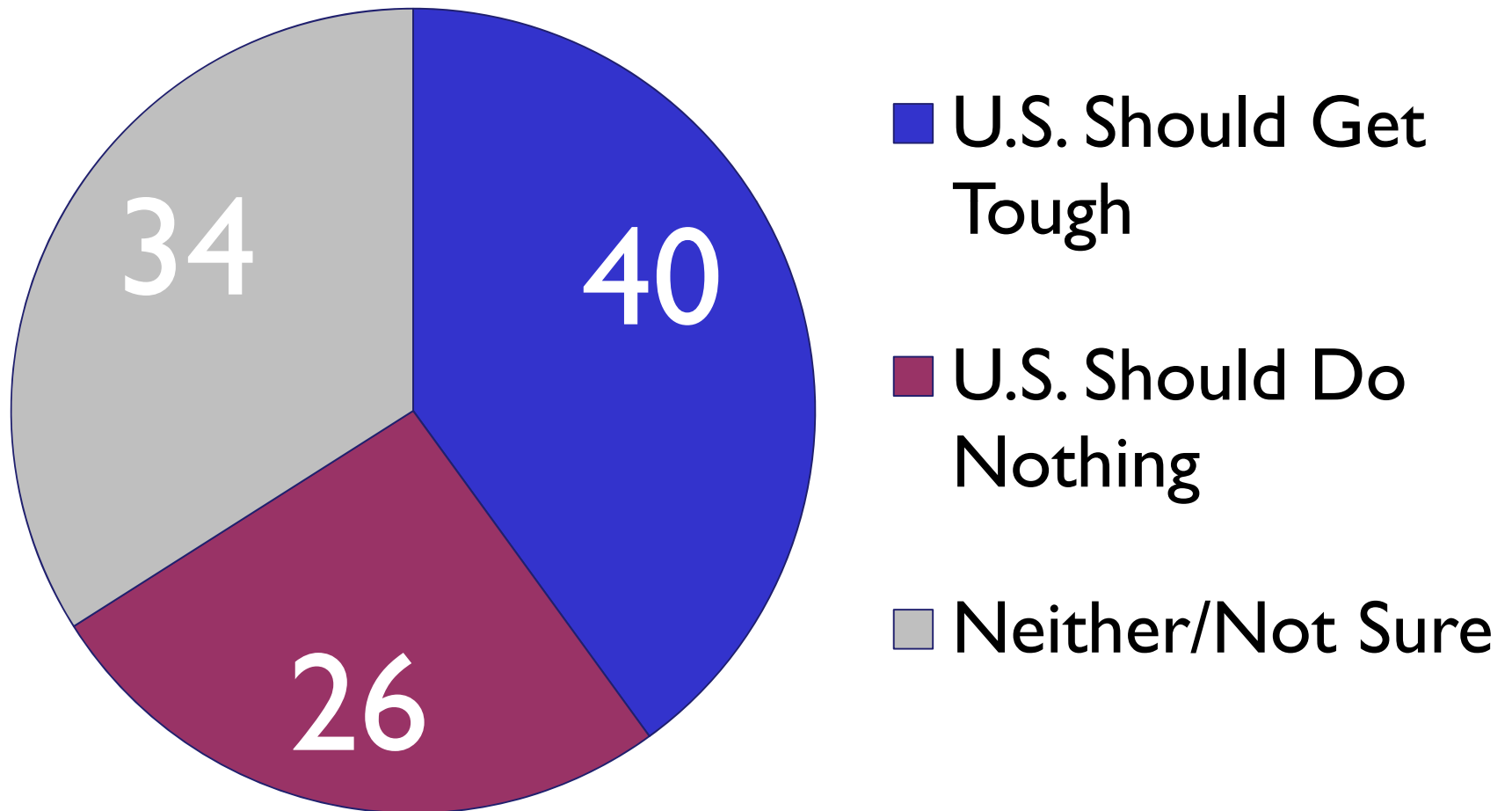

Opinion Toward Israeli Settlements



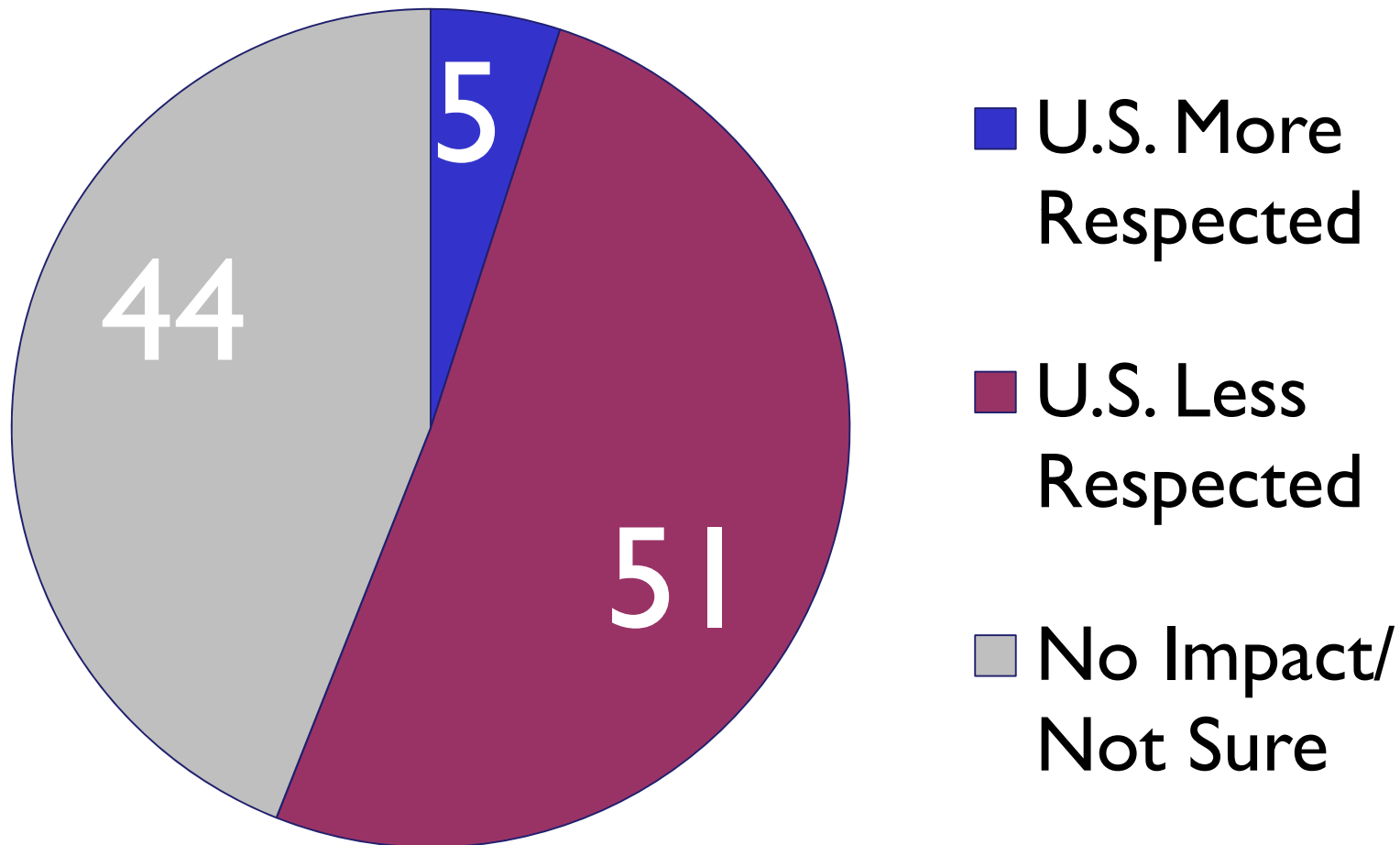

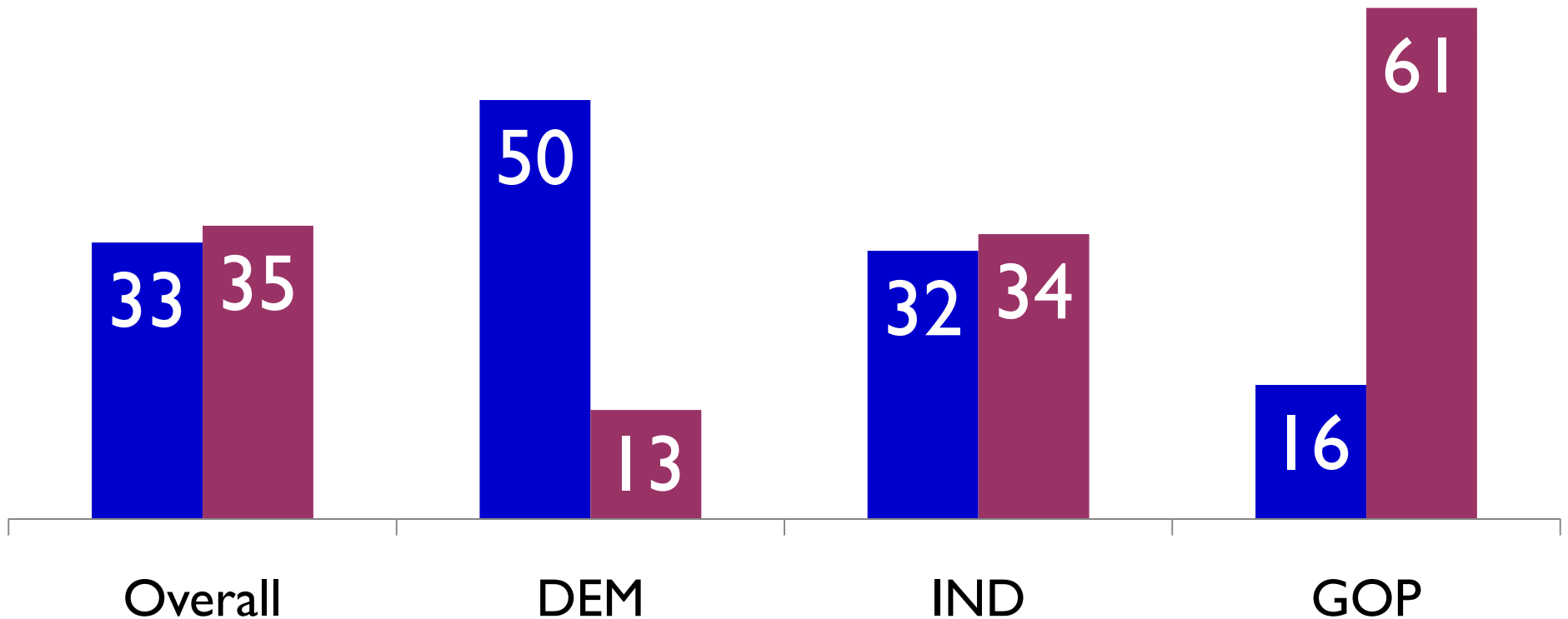
Inability to Stop Settlements Makes ...

Opinion on Jerusalem

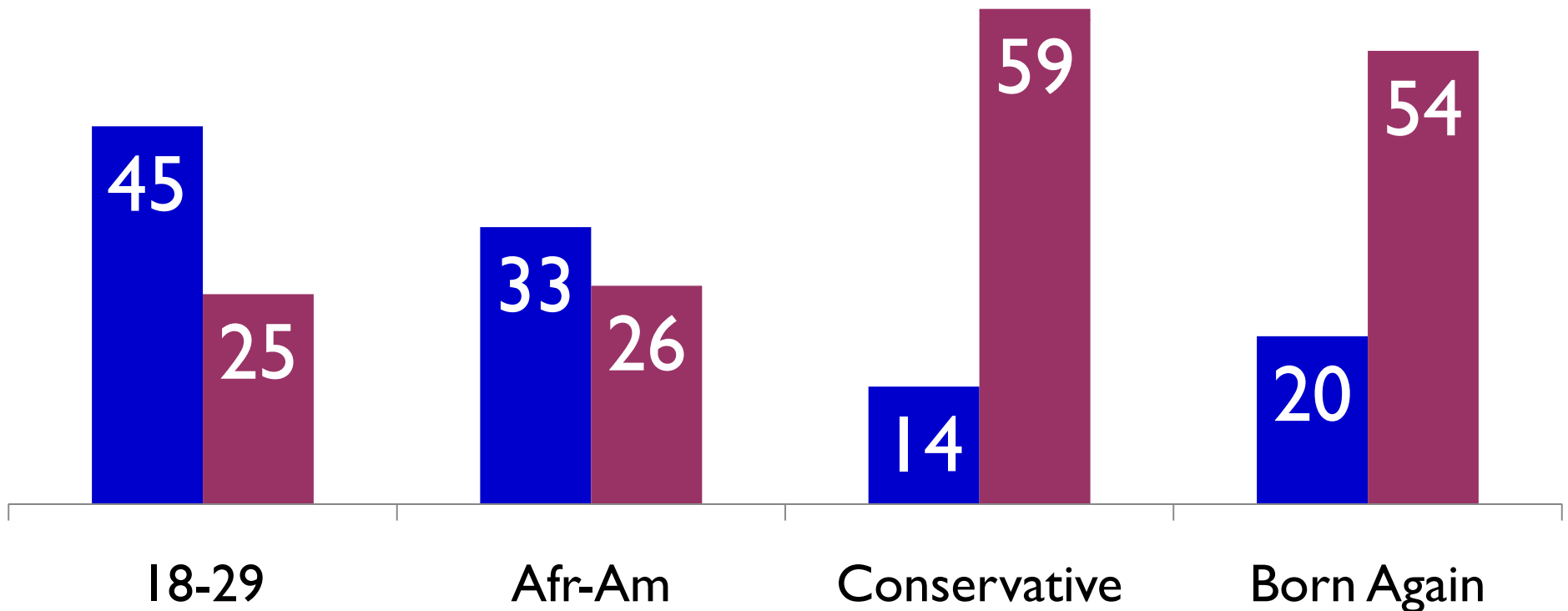

Opinion on Jerusalem

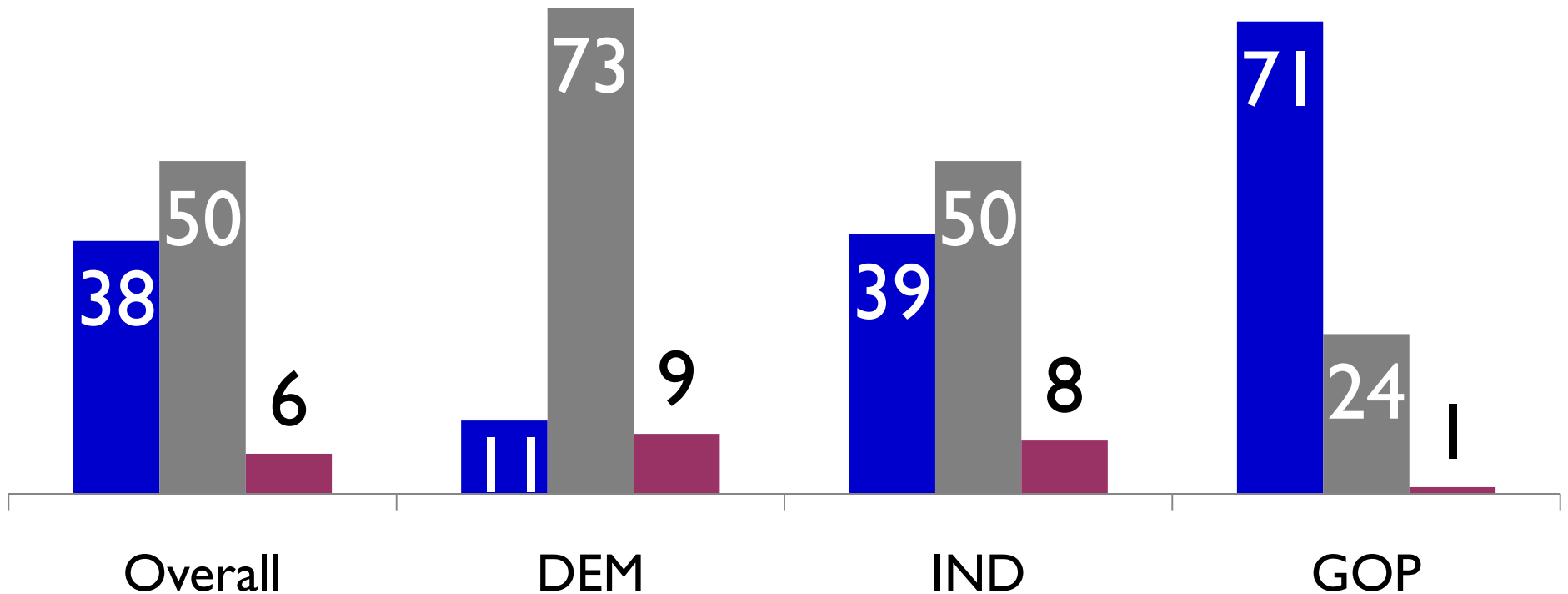

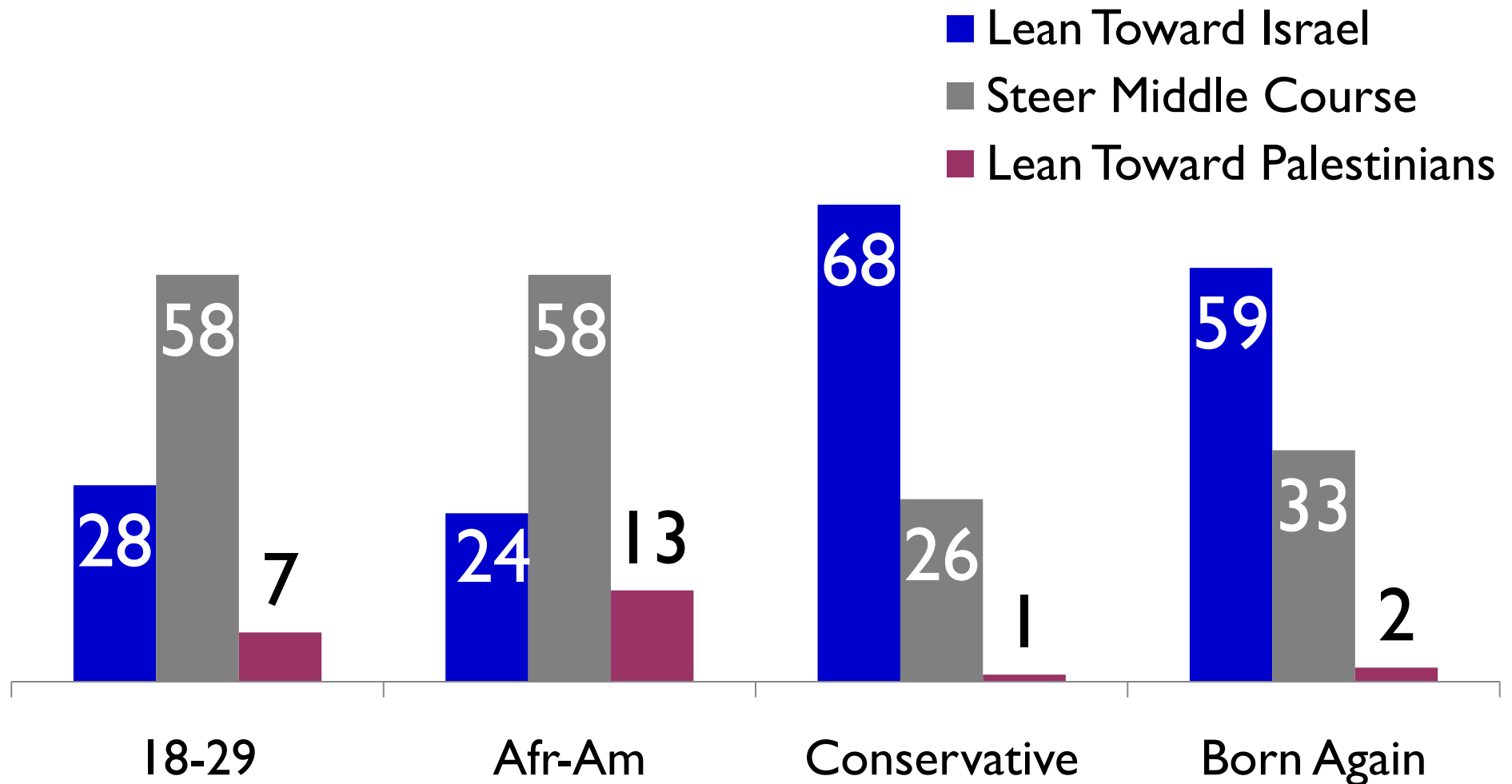
