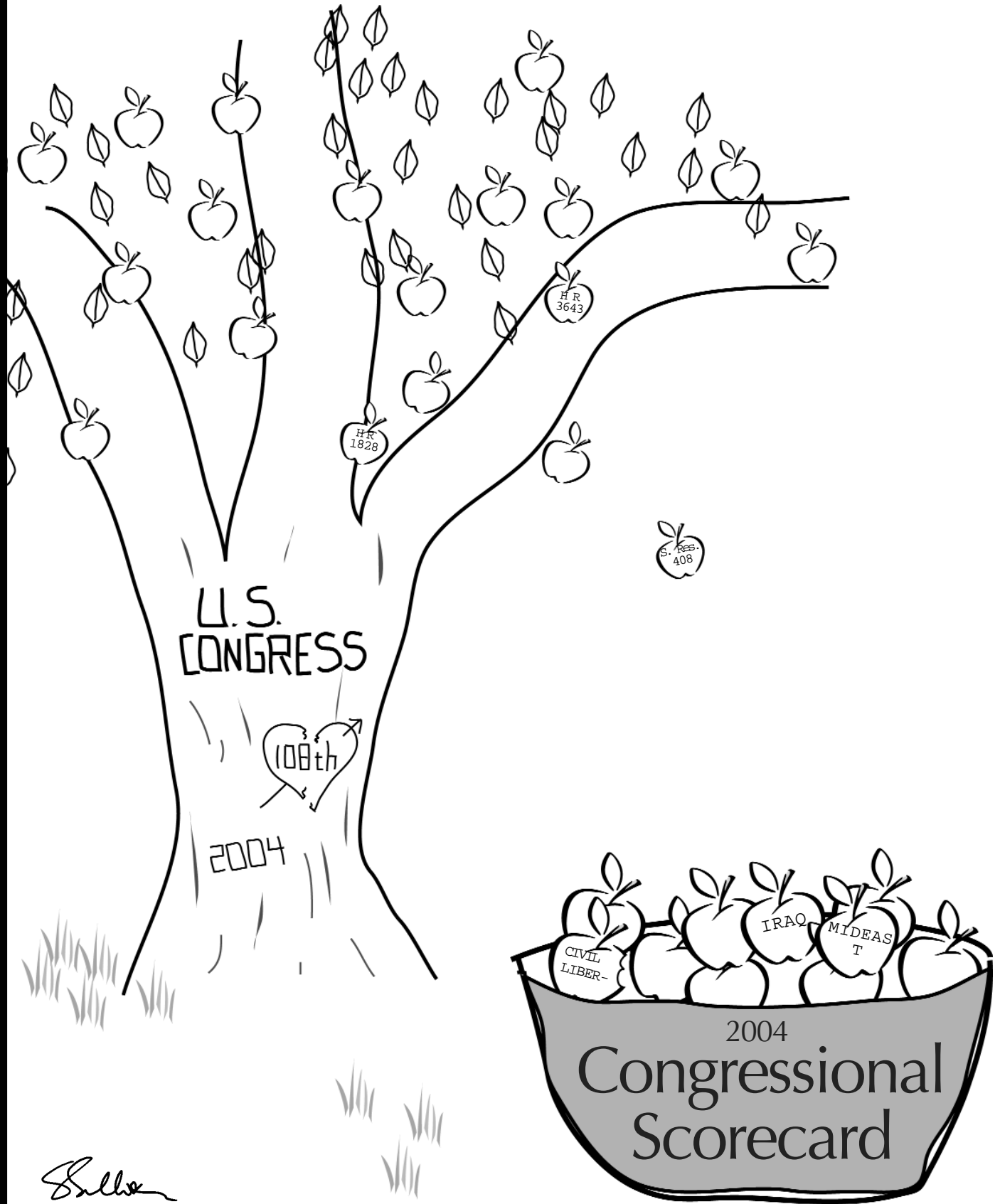

Before you vote on Nov. 2, see how *they* voted!

The Arab American Institute has compiled this Scorecard for the 108th Congress to inform our community of their members' voting records. The Scorecard is based on Congressional actions on a number of issues, outlined below.

While not comprehensive, and while no member of Congress can be judged fairly by any single action, this guide provides a general profile of Congressional behavior that we hope will help Arab Americans better understand actions taken on these key issues.

While it's vital that you cast your vote on Election Day, it's just as important that you *stay* involved throughout the year, by taking action when an issue before Congress, or a decision by any elected officials, affects you. Here are some ways you can take action:

Online

Visit the AAI website (www.aaiusa.org), where you'll find frequently updated information on issues of interest to the Arab American community.

You can contact your Senators and Representative on the Action Alerts portion of our website: just select the issue you're concerned about and enter your zip code to get started.

You'll be prompted to select which of your representatives you'd like to write to and to fill out your name and contact information. We include sample letters and issue briefs to assist you. It's a quick, easy, and effective way to get your message across.

You can also visit your senators' or representative's websites (find them at www.house.gov or www.senate.gov) and send them an email.

Letters

If you'd like to write a personalized letter, keep the following tips in mind:

- Keep the letter concise, polite, and to the point
- Note the name and number of a particular piece of legislation in the letter
- Follow up with a phone call a week or two after sending your letter

Phone Calls

Phone calls are one of the most common, and easiest, means of communicating with your member's office. Keep in mind:

- Ask to speak to the relevant legislative assistant or, in the case of district offices, caseworker.
- Always be polite when expressing your views.
- Follow up with a letter stating your concerns.

Personal Visits

Personal visits, either in your home state/district or in Washington, are the most effective means of communicating with your congressional members. THE ISSUES:

1. Iraq:

S. Res. 28, was a resolution stating that the weapons inspectors in Iraq should be given "sufficient" time for "a thorough assessment of the level of compliance" by Iraq with United Nations Security Council Resolution 1441 (2002). It also stated "the United States should seek a United Nations Security Council resolution specifically authorizing the use of force before initiating any offensive military operations against Iraq." Cosponsors receive a (+).

2. Syria:

Introduced by Senator Barbara Boxer, (D-CA), the Syria Accountability Act of 2003 (S. 982) calls on Syria to "to halt Syrian support for terrorism, end its occupation of Lebanon, stop its development of weapons of mass destruction, cease its illegal importation of Iraqi oil, and hold Syria accountable for its role in the Middle East." The bill, which was eventually incorporated in the House bill H.R. 1828 (which eventually became law), gives the president the power to restrict exports to Syria and to impose other sanctions. This bill complicates U.S.-Syrian relations at a time when it would be more useful that they be strengthened. Those voting for H.R. 1828 receive a (-), while those voting against H.R. 1828 receive a (+).

3. Saudi Arabia:

The Saudi Arabia Accountability Act of 2003 (S. 1888), introduced by Senator Arlen Specter (R-PA), calls for Saudi Arabia to "halt Saudi support for institutions that fund, train, incite, encourage, or in any other way aid and abet terrorism, and to secure full Saudi cooperation in the investigation of terrorist incidents." S. 1888 would give the president the power to prohibit certain exports to Saudi Arabia and restrict the travel of some Saudi diplomats.

Like the Syria legislation cited above, this legislation complicates relations with an important Arab nation at an inopportune time. Cosponsors of the bill receive a (-).

4. Israel-Palestine/Separation Wall:

S. Res. 408, introduced by Senator Gordon Smith (R-OR) supports "the construction by Israel of a security fence," condemns "the decision of the International Court of Justice on the legality of the security fence," and urges "no further action by the United Nations to delay or prevent the construction of the security fence." Cosponsors of the resolution receive a (-).

5. Civil Liberties:

Introduced by Senator Larry Craig (R-ID), S. 1709, the Security and Freedom Ensured Act of

2003 (SAFE Act) seeks to "amend the USA PATRIOT ACT to place reasonable limitations on the use of surveillance and the issuance of search warrants." Cosponsors received a (+).

6. Hate Crimes:

S. 966, Local Law Enforcement Enhancement Act of 2003 (S. 966), introduced by Senator Edward Kennedy (D-MA), seeks to "provide Federal assistance to States and local jurisdictions to prosecute hate crimes." Cosponsors of the bill receive a (+).

7. Special Category:

Some of the specific actions for which Senators received a (+) or a (-) are:

(a) (+) Senators who cosponsored S. 2528, the Civil Liberties Restoration Act (CLRA), which seeks to "restore civil liberties under the First Amendment, the Immigration and Nationality Act, and the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act."

(b) (+) For Senators Susan Collins (R-ME) and Ron Wyden (D-OR), who cosponsored S. 2536, the Homeland Security Civil Rights and Civil Liberties Protection Act of 2004, "a bill to enumerate the responsibilities of the Officer for Civil Rights and Civil Liberties of the Department of Homeland Security, to require the Inspector General of the Department of Homeland Security to designate a senior official to investigate civil rights complaints, and for other purposes."

(c) (+) For Senators Chuck Hagel (R-NE) and Tom Daschle (D-SD) for cosponsoring S. 2010, the Immigration Reform Act of 2004, a positive attempt at comprehensive immigration reform.

(d) (-) For Senators Hillary Clinton (D-NY), Chuck Schumer (D-NY), Orrin Hatch (R-UT), and Gordon Smith (R-OR) for co-authoring a Dear Colleague letter to United Nations Secretary General Kofi Annan urging him to "reverse" his support for the International Court of Justice's examination into Israel's separation wall.

(e) (-) For Senators who cosponsored the Homeland Security Enhancement Act (S. 1906), introduced by Senator Jeff Sessions (R-AL), which would burden local police with federal immigration enforcement responsibilities or face a lack of funding.

1. Syria:

Introduced by Rep. Elliot Engel (D-NY), the Syria Accountability and Lebanese Sovereignty Restoration Act of 2003 (H.R. 1828), calls on Syria to “halt Syrian support for terrorism, end its occupation of Lebanon, stop its development of weapons of mass destruction, cease its illegal importation of Iraqi oil and illegal shipments of weapons and other military items to Iraq, and by so doing hold Syria accountable for the serious international security problems it has caused in the Middle East.” H.R. 1828 gives the president the power to restrict exports to Syria and to impose other sanctions. This bill, which eventually became law, complicates U.S.-Syrian relations at a time when it would be more useful that they be strengthened. Those voting for the bill receive a (-), while those voting against the bill or not voting at all receive a (+).

2. Saudi Arabia:

The Saudi Arabia Accountability Act of 2003 (H.R. 3643), introduced by Rep. Anthony Weiner (D-NY), calls for Saudi Arabia to “halt Saudi support for institutions that fund, train, incite, encourage, or in any other way aid and abet terrorism, and to secure full Saudi cooperation in the investigation of terrorist incidents.” S. 1888 would give the president the power to prohibit certain exports to Saudi Arabia and restrict the travel of some Saudi diplomats. Like the Syria legislation cited above, this legislation complicates relations with an important Arab nation at an inopportune time. Cosponsors of the bill receive a (-).

3. Israel-Palestine/Unbalance Resolution:

Introduced by Rep. Tom DeLay (R-TX), H. Con. Res. 460, “Regarding the security of Israel and the principles of peace in the Middle East” is an unbalanced resolution that does little but strengthen the impression that the United States is not a fair arbiter in this conflict. Those who voted in favor received a (-), those who voted against or abstained received a (+).

4. Israel-Palestine/Separation Wall:

Introduced by Rep. Mike Pence (R-IN), H. Con. Res. 371 calls for support for “the construction by Israel of a security fence” and condemns “the decision by the United Nations General Assembly to request the International Court of Justice to render an opinion on the legality of the security fence.” Cosponsors of the bill receive a (-).

5. Immigration:

Introduced by Rep. Charlie Norwood (R-GA), H.R. 2671, Clear Law Enforcement for Criminal Alien Removal Act (CLEAR Act) would burden local police with federal immigration enforcement responsibilities or face a lack of funding. This action, opposed by police departments across the country, would undermine the relationship between police and immigrant communities and add an additional burden to already overburdened police departments. Cosponsors of the bill receive a (-).

6. Hate Crimes:

Introduced by Rep. John Conyers (D-MI), the Local Law Enforcement Hate Crimes Prevention Act of 2004 (H.R. 4204) seeks to “provide Federal assistance to States and local jurisdictions to prosecute hate crimes.” Cosponsors of the bill receive a (+).

7. Civil Liberties:

Introduced by Rep. Butch Otter (R-ID), H.R. 3352, the Security and Freedom Ensured Act of 2003 (SAFE Act), seeks to amend “the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 and title 18, United States Code, to strengthen protections of civil liberties in the exercise of the foreign intelligence surveillance authorities under Federal law.” Cosponsors of the bill received a (+).

8. Special Category:

Some of the specific actions receiving a (+) or a (-) are:

(a) (+) For Representatives who cosponsored H.R. 4591, the Civil Liberties Restoration Act (CLRA), which seeks to “restore civil liberties under the First Amendment, the Immigration and Nationality Act, and the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act.”

(b) (+) For Reps. Alcee Hastings (D-FL) and Tom Udall (D-NM) for cosponsoring H. Res. 55, calling for sufficient time for UN Inspection in Iraq and calling for the U.S. to seek UN Security Council approval for military action.

(c) (+) For all cosponsors of H.R. 3171, the Benjamin Franklin True Patriot Act, originally sponsored by Rep. Dennis Kucinich (D-OH), which seeks to “provide for an appropriate review of recently enacted legislation relating to terrorism to assure that powers granted in it do not inappropriately undermine civil liberties.”

(d) (-) For all cosponsors of H. Con. Res. 363, “Expressing the grave concern of Congress regarding the continuing gross violations of human rights and civil liberties of the Syrian people by the Government of the Syrian Arab Republic.” Rep. Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL) originally sponsored the legislation.

(e) (+) For Rep. Henry Hyde (R-IL), Chairman of the House Committee on International Relations, for his March 25, 2004 letter to Sec. of State Colin Powell stating his concerns regarding the effect the route of the Israeli separation wall on Christian worshipers, congregations, and Christian-owned and Church-owned land.

(f) (-) For cosponsors of H.R. 3077, “To amend title VI of the Higher Education Act of 1965 to enhance international education programs.” Section Six of the bill proposes the creation of an “International Higher Education Advisory Board,” which would have the power to severely restrict area studies programs, such as those that focus on the Middle East. The powers given to the Advisory Board in the bill are poorly defined and could enable the appointed members to create a “correctness regime” apparatus.

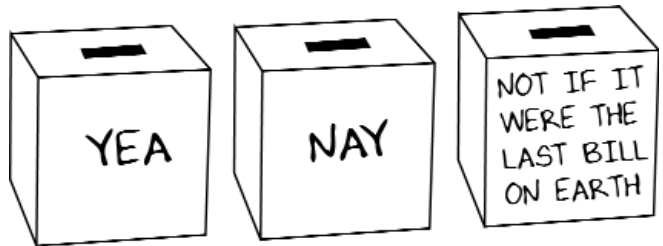

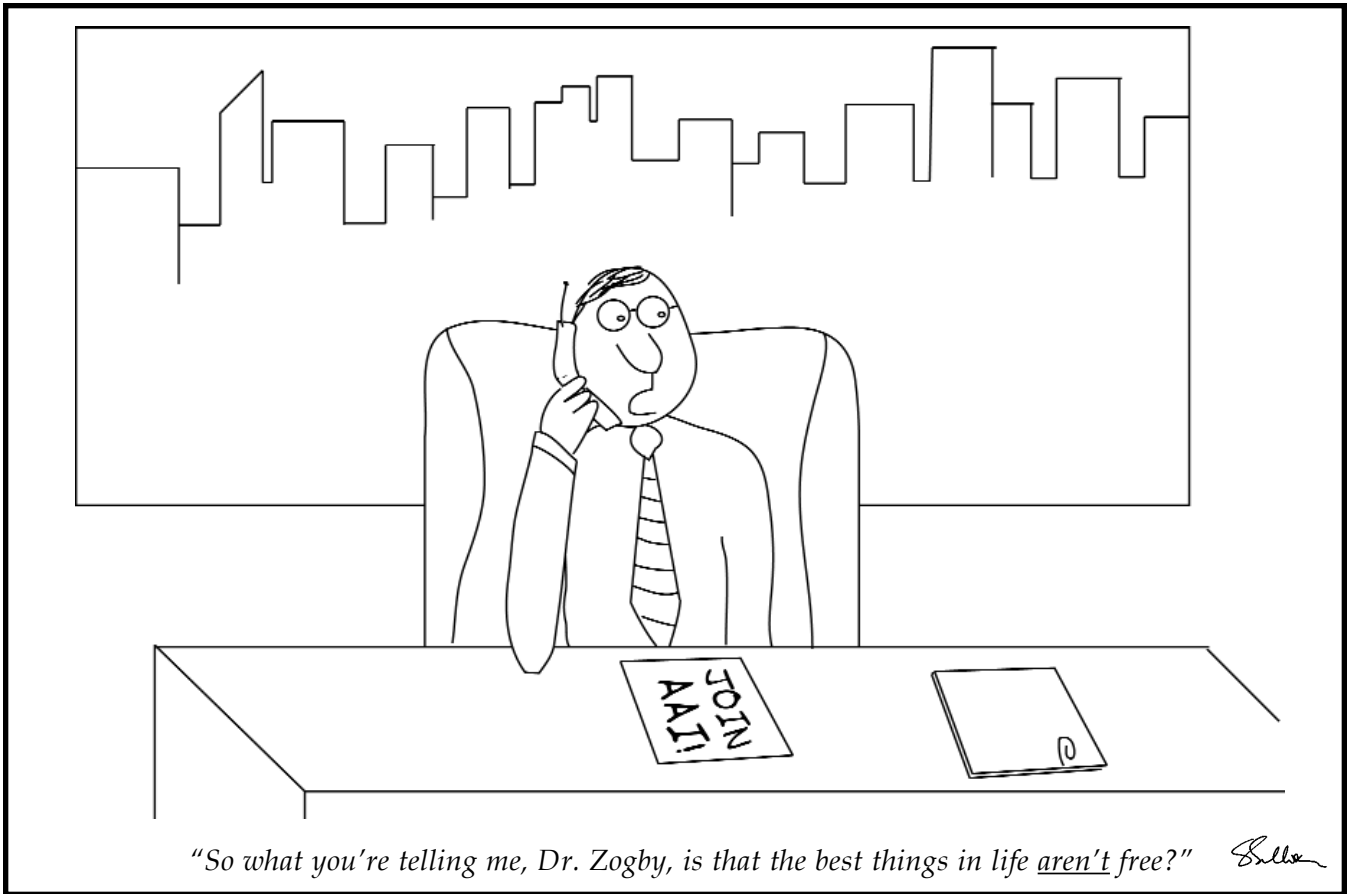
