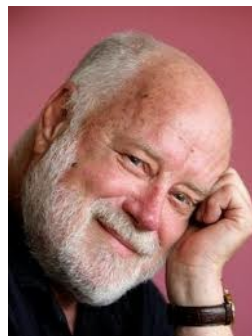

ABC services in the Hunter

When & What took place

- 1930 December 16, 2NC Newcastle
- 1940
- 1946 September 1, 2NA Radio National started broadcasts to Newcastle and the Hunter
That later changed with 2NC becoming the frequency for local radio 1233 ABC Newcastle and 2NA the network for Radio National in Newcastle.
- 1950
- 1960
- 1960's ABC television launched in Newcastle
- 1964 2UH Upper Hunter on relay from Newcastle
- 1970
- 1976 ABC Classic FM launched in Sydney that is now networked around Australia
- 1978 November 23—frequencies of most radio stations changed to take account of the coming FM stations
- 1980 News staff had increased to six at 1233 ABC Newcastle
- 1982 News and talk became the dominant program content, with music being left to FM stations.
- 1990 2UH Upper Hunter, Local studio opened with Rural Reporter and News Journalist appointed
- 1990's Triple J starts in Newcastle
- 1993 1233 ABC Newcastle moves to new studios, Cnr Wood and Parry Streets, Newcastle West
- 1994 August, Parliamentary and News Network commenced
- 1997 2UH Upper Hunter moved to new studios in Brook Street, Muswellbrook.
