The OUTSaskatoon Summer Student is responsible for providing support to OUTSaskatoon's essential support services hub. This includes providing direct services pertaining to housing, food security, systems navigation, and peer support.

OUTSaskatoon is dedicated to building an organization that reflects the diversity of all we serve. This includes prioritizing applicants that are diverse in gender, sexuality, culture, and race. Tasks:

- 1. Work within the OUT HUB team to offer essential front-line in-person support services.
- 2. Uphold health and safety guidelines for staff and clients in the OUT HUB.
- 3. Complete daily statistical reporting when stationed in the OUT HUB.
- 4. Assist with social groups and programming as needed.
- 5. Assist with the re-opening plan for our Drop-in.
- 6. Monthly statistical record-keeping and reporting and performance of other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

This job is open to High School graduates who intend to enter post-secondary studies in the fall and to post-secondary students who are planning to return to school in the fall.

Knowledge of Two Spirit, Trans, Queer, and BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and People of Colour) communities and issues is essential. Experience working for community-based organizations &/or working in the queer community is an asset.

Working Conditions: The incumbent works in an office environment that follows strict Covid-19 protocols and guidelines. Will need to lift and move furniture, storage bins, etc.
