## **KEY STATUTORY ROLES OF REGULATORY AGENCIES**

NZ Police	Medical Officers of Health (MOoH)	Licensing inspectors of local council
Power and key roles		
<ul> <li>Inquire and provide report on the licence application meeting the criteria of the Act</li> <li>Power of entry to any licensed premises for inspection</li> <li>Power to request any information/document required by the Act</li> <li>Power to seizure any sample of alcohol at the time of inspection</li> <li>Power to issue infringement notice and prosecution</li> <li>Order the closure of licensed premises when riot, fight, serious disorder and serious threat to public health/safety, etc.</li> <li>Liaise with event organiser for large-scale event (special licence)</li> <li>Advise ARLA when a licensee or manager has been convicted of an offence relating to</li> <li>the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, or</li> <li>allowing persons to become intoxicated</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Inquire and provide report on the licence application meeting the criteria of the Act</li> <li>MOoH has a statutory reporting role to DLCs and ARLA</li> <li>May delegate powers and functions to qualified trained person</li> <li>Apply to ARLA for suspension of an onlicence or a club licence where there is evidence of non-compliance with section 21B of the Fire Service Act 1975 (provide and maintain an evacuation scheme in the case of fire incidence)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Inquire and provide report on the licence application meeting the criteria of the Act</li> <li>Power of entry to any licensed premises</li> <li>Power to seize alcohol and containers without a warrant for the purpose of analysis</li> <li>Monitor licensed premises compliance with the Act</li> <li>Work with the Police and event organiser for large-scale event (special licence)</li> <li>Apply to ARLA for variation, suspension and cancellation of licences and manager's certificate</li> </ul>
