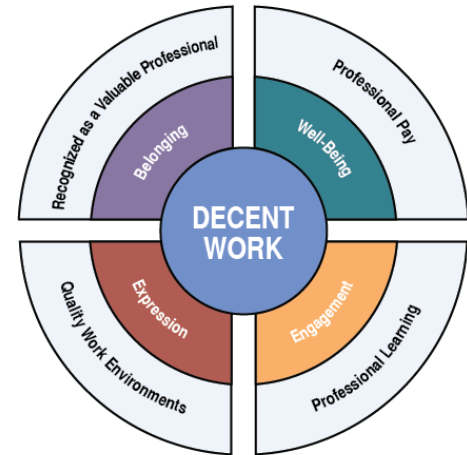


To build and support a strong collective voice for early childhood educators so they can participate in and influence positive change that benefits ECEs, children, families and communities.

Decent work for early childhood educators and early years staff is a foundational pillar in building a better future for children and families in Ontario.

Decent Work is recognition of staff as valued professionals, professional pay/compensation, professional learning, and quality and supportive work environments.

- Host meet and greets with ECEs and early years staff in local communities
- Host Continuous Professional Learning workshops on advocacy
- Engage community members with the Decent Work Task Force's policy recommendations
- Network with MPPs, City Councillors and School Board Trustees
- Canvas neighbourhoods and hold local actions about the importance of early years during elections
