## Pensions/OAS

*How to be sure retirement will be good to you; how current changes are risking that.*

Increasing the country's retirement age to 67 has very real impacts on the sustainability of our social programs and the possibilities for retirement security. Learn about the politics of pensions, how to be sure retirement will be good to you, and how current changes put workers at risk of having no choice but to work longer and for less.

## Drug Testing

*Current and changing laws; the impact on human rights and dignity.*

Random testing is not only an affront to the dignity and basic human rights of workers; it doesn't actually improve safety in a substantial way. Learn about current and changing laws and the impact to worker rights, health and safety.

## Employment Insurance

*How to beat the maze and receive the rights you paid for.*

The erosion of Employment Insurance (EI) leaves Canada on a crash course towards conditions that clearly favour employers, not working people. Learn about the impacts of changes to EI, including how they're designed to force workers to take low-paying jobs or have their unemployment benefits cut off.

## Temporary Foreign Workers

*How to help reduce the abuse and know the pitfalls of the program.*

The Temporary Foreign Worker Program (TFW) is not immigration. It's exploitation. This course will look specifically at how the TFW is being leveraged by Conservatives and employers to drive down wages and working conditions across Alberta and Canada.

# Olds College Dormitory-Style Rooms & Packing List

## unit furnishings

### townhouse only

Each Townhouse is completely furnished for each guest:

- kitchen equipped with a full size fridge, and stove
- coffee table, side table
- vacuum
- blinds for the windows
- each living room is equipped with a telephone jack and a cable outlet
- Note: wireless service is not available in housing.
- round kitchen table (with 4 chairs)
- couch, 2 living room chairs
- small garbage can
- tack board at the entry
- utility room equipped with washer, dryer, freezer

### room furnishings

Each room has the following furnishings for each guest:

- single bed (captain's bed with 3 large drawers) (39" x 80")
- basic bedding, pillows and towels
- closet with shelf
- blinds for the windows
- mattress and mattress cover
- built-in desk and chair
- small garbage can
- large tack board along wall

### storage

Residents of College Courts have a storage area in the crawl space of the townhouses for bikes, trunks, suitcases, skis, and other large items.

### laundry

For your convenience a washer and dryer are installed on the 2nd level of each Townhouse.

## things you need to bring (packing list)

### laundry supplies
