**RE: Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) Act  
Access to Information Request – File #2013-G-0001**

Further to our letter of January 7, 2013, we have completed a search of our files for the records you requested. We have found 26 pages of records that are responsive to your request.

Of these, 22 pages are documents that have been prepared for Cabinet and, as such, must not be disclosed under s. 22(1) of the FOIP Act. The remaining four pages cannot be disclosed because they consist of advice to a minister and may reveal the substance of Cabinet discussions. These four pages are excepted from disclosure under both s. 22(1) and s. 24(1)(a) of the Act.

Under section 65 of the FOIP Act, you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner for a review of this finding. To request a review, you must complete and deliver a *Request for Review* form within 60 days from the date of this letter, to the Commissioner at 410, 9925 – 109 Street, Edmonton, AB, T5K 2J8.
