

AFL Kids' Camp 2015 Waiver and Release Form

This release is necessary to ensure that all parties, parents, campers and leaders, understand and agree that the officers, staff and agents of the AFL Kids' Camp and the Alberta Federation of Labour cannot be held liable for any injury or damage as a result of activities at Kids' Camp.

Release

The **undersigned ("Camper")** is aware that participation in residential camp activities may result in accident or injury and assumes the risk connected with the participation in any camp activity and represents that the Camper is in good health or that the AFL Kids' Camp has been informed of any physical impairment which would limit their participation in the Alberta Federation of Labour Kids' Camp.

Camper agrees that officers, staff and agents of the AFL Kids' Camp will be permitted to administer first-aid if necessary. Camper specifically agrees that the Alberta Federation of Labour Kids' Camp, its officers, employees and agents shall not be liable for claim, demand or cause of action of any kind whatsoever for or on account of death, personal injury, property damage or loss of any kind resulting from or related to camper's participation in any Alberta Federation of Labour Kids' Camp activity within or without the Alberta Federation of Labour Kids' Camp, and camper agrees to hold Alberta Federation of Labour harmless the same.

Note: The camper must be of age to exercise this release. All registered Campers and Junior Counsellors must have their parent or guardian's signature. Adult Leaders must sign as Camper and need not complete birth date information.
