

AFL Kids' Camp

Rules

1. All Camp boundaries and rules will be respected. No one leaves the campgrounds without permission.
2. The AFL harassment policy will be in effect. This means that we expect all to be treated with respect and civility. There will be zero tolerance for any harassment or discrimination of any kind.
3. While near or in the water, the lifeguard is to be obeyed at all times.
4. Campers should not have phones, electronic games or devices. Any of these items brought to camp will be confiscated and returned at the end of camp. We are not responsible for the loss of any personal items.
5. Campers should not go into other cabins unless they are invited for a specific purpose. Privacy should be respected at all times. Boys will not go into girls cabins and girls will not go into boys cabins.
6. Campers will line up for meals. Meals will start and end with announcements. Campers will be required to clear and wipe tables, sweep, stack chairs and mop.
7. Campers are expected to be on time for meals and activities. We will be packing a lot into a short time and we do not want to waste valuable playtime waiting for others.
8. Campers are expected to shower each day after swimming and to brush their teeth and wash before bed.
9. Cabins will be inspected for cleanliness each morning during the curriculum session, and a report will be given at lunch.
