### **McMaster readies for student move-in**

This year's class will move into their campus residences on August 26 and August 27. Parking and security Services have assisted in the preparation of the plans to move traffic from neighbourhood streets onto and through campus as quickly and efficiently as possible.

On **Saturday, August 26** over 1,100 first-year students will move into North Quad residences Edwards, Hedden, McKay, and Whidden. Vehicles will be directed to enter campus through the Sterling Street entrance or north on Forsyth Avenue.

On **Sunday, August 27th** North Quad residences Brandon, Les Prince, and Woodstock, and all five West Quad residence buildings (Bates, Mary E. Keyes, Matthews, Moulton, Wallingford) will move-in. Residents moving into Bates and Moulton will enter off Cootes Drive. Residents moving into Mary E. Keyes, Matthews and Wallingford will enter campus off of Main St. West.

### **Welcome Week**

McMaster's annual Welcome Week activities will begin August 26 and will run until September 2. During that time, incoming students will attend a number of events and programs designed to help smooth their transition to university life. These include opening ceremonies, concerts, orientation programs, and more. This year's PJ Parade takes place Saturday, September 2 traveling around the Westdale community and ending at King Street for the Westdale Westfest. Classes begin on Tuesday, September 5.

There will be concerts taking place August 29 and September 1, both ending by 11 p.m. The University is funding additional off-duty police officers and Hamilton Police will have additional on-duty officers bolstering the regular patrols in Westdale and Ainslie Wood.
