Undocumented immigrants have rights.

You Have The Right To:

REMAIN SILENT

If you want to exercise that right, you should say it out loud. You can say,

"I will not answer your questions. I will remain silent until I speak to an attorney."

SPEAK TO A LAWYER

Before answering any questions, you can say,

"I will remain silent until I speak to an attorney."

REFUSE TO SIGN ANYTHING

You do not have to sign anything. You can say,

"I will not sign anything. I will remain silent until I speak to an attorney."

REFUSE THE SEARCH OF YOUR HOME

If law enforcement comes to your home:

- **DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR!**
- Ask the officer to slide the warrant under the door
- Make sure it is signed by a judge

You can say,

"I do not give you permission to enter. I will remain silent until I speak to an attorney."

ASK IF YOU ARE BEING DETAINED

If stopped by law enforcement, you can ask if you are free to leave.

If they say yes,
CALMLY WALK AWAY

If they say no,
YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT!
