

Changing Expulsion of a Member and Executive

- Amend Article 2(7) – Any Member, except the Leader of the Party, may be expelled from membership by a majority vote of the Board of Directors upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee, and upon hearing from the Executive Committee and the Member. The Executive Committee must provide **no** less than **seven (7)** days written notice to the Member of the date and time of the Board of Directors’ meeting and of **their** right to speak. The membership rights and privileges of any Member so expelled shall cease immediately upon a majority vote of the Board members present at the meeting.
- Amend Article 4(7) - Except for the Leader of the Party or Designate, any Member of the Executive Committee maybe expelled by the Board of Directors, upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee and upon hearing from the Executive Committee and the Member. The Executive Committee must provide **no** less than **seven (7)** days written notice to the Member of the date and time of the Board of Directors’ meeting and of **their** right to speak. The rights and privileges of the Executive Committee Member so expelled shall cease immediately upon a two-thirds majority vote of the Board Members present at the meeting.

Removal of the Immediate Past President and Commission Positions

- Strike Articles 3(4)(i), (m), (n), (o), and (p)
- Strike Article 4(3)(h)
- Amend Article 12(2) – In case of a conflict between the provisions of these Bylaws or the bylaws of any Provincial Constituency, or any additional procedures or convention rules, these Bylaws shall be deemed to take precedence.

Clarification of Appointed Roles and Remuneration

Amend Article 4(5) - The President, Vice President, Policy Chair, Secretary and Treasurer shall be elected by the Members of the Party. The Fundraising Chair shall be appointed by the Leader of the Party. The Constituency Chair shall be appointed by the President.

- (a) The Fundraising Chair and the Constituency Chair shall serve for a one (1) year term and the position shall be filled at the Annual General Meeting.
 - i. In the event of a vacancy in the position of Fundraising Chair before the next Annual General Meeting, the Leader of the Party may appoint a new person as Fundraising Chair.
 - ii. In the event of a vacancy in the position of Constituency Chair before the next Annual General Meeting, the President may appoint a new person as Constituency Chair
- (b) No member of the Executive Committee shall receive remuneration from the Party in return for **their** services as a member of the Executive Committee, other than for disbursements **and other Party expenses** actually incurred.

Amending the Bylaws

Amend Article 11

3. A majority of **two-thirds** of the votes cast at a meeting is required for approval of a Special Resolution amending **these** Bylaws.
4. The amended Bylaws take effect after approval of the Special Resolution **or the coming in to force date if so specified** and acceptance by the **Registrar of Corporations**.
5. **After every Meeting where the Bylaws have been amended, the Executive shall oversee the publication of the Bylaws as amended and may, in so doing, and subject to the ratification of the Board of Directors:**
 - a. **Renumber the provisions of the Bylaws to accommodate the changes that have been made;**
 - b. **Correct typographical errors, spelling errors, and cross-references between provisions which are no longer accurate;**
 - c. **Correct errors which are purely typographical;**
 - d. **Replace gender biased language with gender neutral language; and,**
 - e. **Correct any other inconsistencies only insofar as such changes will not change the substantive meaning of any provision.**
