

War Criminals

This Congress:

- believing that the failure to bring to trial those accused of crimes against humanity in former Yugoslavia undermines respect for international law, encourages repetition of such appalling crimes and makes the establishment of peace ever more difficult;

1. Calls on SFOR to carry out, at the earliest opportunity, the warrants for arrest so that those charged with crimes against humanity are brought before the International Tribunal in The Hague;

2. Asks its President to send this resolution to all the Governments contributing to SFOR
