

Petition Calling for Removal of Oxford Street Clearway

To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in NSW

This petition of the people of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

Residents and business operators in Paddington are concerned about speeding traffic, pedestrian safety, cyclist safety and parking on Oxford Street. Oxford Street traders are concerned that this high street shopping precinct cannot compete with major shopping centre developments unless shoppers can stop to buy from their businesses.

Current traffic arrangements reduce amenity and discourage shoppers. Oxford Street is a popular pedestrian and cycle route, with reduced traffic as a result of the Eastern Distributor Tollway and Cross City Tunnel. The City of Sydney, Woollahra Municipal Council, business and resident groups all support removal of the Clearway.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask that the Government remove the Clearway on Oxford Street and impose a 40kph speed limit in Oxford Street.
