

# Petition Calling for Better Bus Services in Ultimo and Pymont

*To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in NSW  
This petition of the people of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:*

Urban consolidation and redevelopment has increased population in Pymont and Ultimo, with more than 20,000 people on the peninsula – now the most densely populated area in Australia. Public transport services have not expanded to meet need. Traffic changes associated with the Glebe Island/ANZAC Bridge and Cross City Tunnel reduced access to bus services, and removal of the Monorail further reduced access to public transport. Light rail services are regularly full. People will use public transport if it is regular and reliable, and takes them where they need to go. Poor bus services result in fewer people using public transport, which results in the appearance that the services are not needed or can be reduced. Expanded public transport is needed to address inner city traffic congestion and unhealthy air pollution.

***The undersigned petitioners therefore ask that the government improve bus services to Pymont and Ultimo.***
