

Petition calling for Refusal of the Sydney Metro Pitt Street Over Station Development

To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in NSW: this petition of the people of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

Proposed towers of 166 and 150 metres above the Pitt Street north and south metro stations respectively represent overdevelopments of the sites. They fail to comply with planning requirements resulting in unacceptable impacts on adjacent communities. The mixed use high-rises are too tall and bulky and would block sunlight in Hyde Park during the colder months in breach of the Hyde Park West sun access plane, and in over 100 homes, dropping their winter sunlight to less than two hours a day – well below minimum standards.

Plans should be revised to protect amenity in Hyde Park and neighbouring homes.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask the Minister for Planning to reject the over station developments above the Sydney Metro Pitt Street stations in their current form.
