
Meredith Dolan

Her early family life was deeply impacted by serious mental illnesses of loved ones—an experience that has given her sensitivities for families navigating the complex sometimes overwhelming world of treatment and recovery. As a wife and young mother, she overcame the valleys of mental health challenges stemming from postpartum anxiety.

She remains a committed advocate for families in need by volunteering with organizations like North Hills Community Outreach, Foster Love Project, and Second Harvest Thrift Store. She's also been a volunteer and supporter of N Street Village—an organization providing housing for victims of abuse, addicts, and those experiencing homelessness.

A graduate of Ohio University, Meredith's professional career spans from her first job as a 16-year-old lifeguard to becoming chief-of-staff to a member of Congress in Washington, DC. The experience allowed her to develop expertise on policies ranging from clean water and environmental issues to road, rail, and air transportation policy. Aware that no one achieves success alone, she has mentored countless young women and men throughout her career. In 2017, she and her husband Greg—a fellow Capitol Hill staffer—left DC and returned home to Allegheny County to raise their growing family.


complaining, looking like they are bothered and annoyed at everything, but in reality, they do precious little to address the actual problems facing our families and communities.
