Dear Fellow Republicans,

With Labor Day comes the formal end of summer and the "official" beginning of campaign season.

You can rest assured that our County Council, Court of Common Pleas, mayoral, and local Republican candidates didn't wait for the "official" beginning. Most have been hard at work throughout the summer; taking their message directly to you, the voters.

As a member of Allegheny County Council, I formally introduced three pieces of legislation that I hope will provide for more openness and transparency in our election process.

My legislation seeks to:

- Allow for public viewing of the pre-election set up, including vote scanning machines and scanners used to count mail in ballots as well as accuracy testing.
- Allow for the appointment of watchers to any county conducted election audit.
- Allow for a video feed of any vote pre-cavassing or counting that takes
