

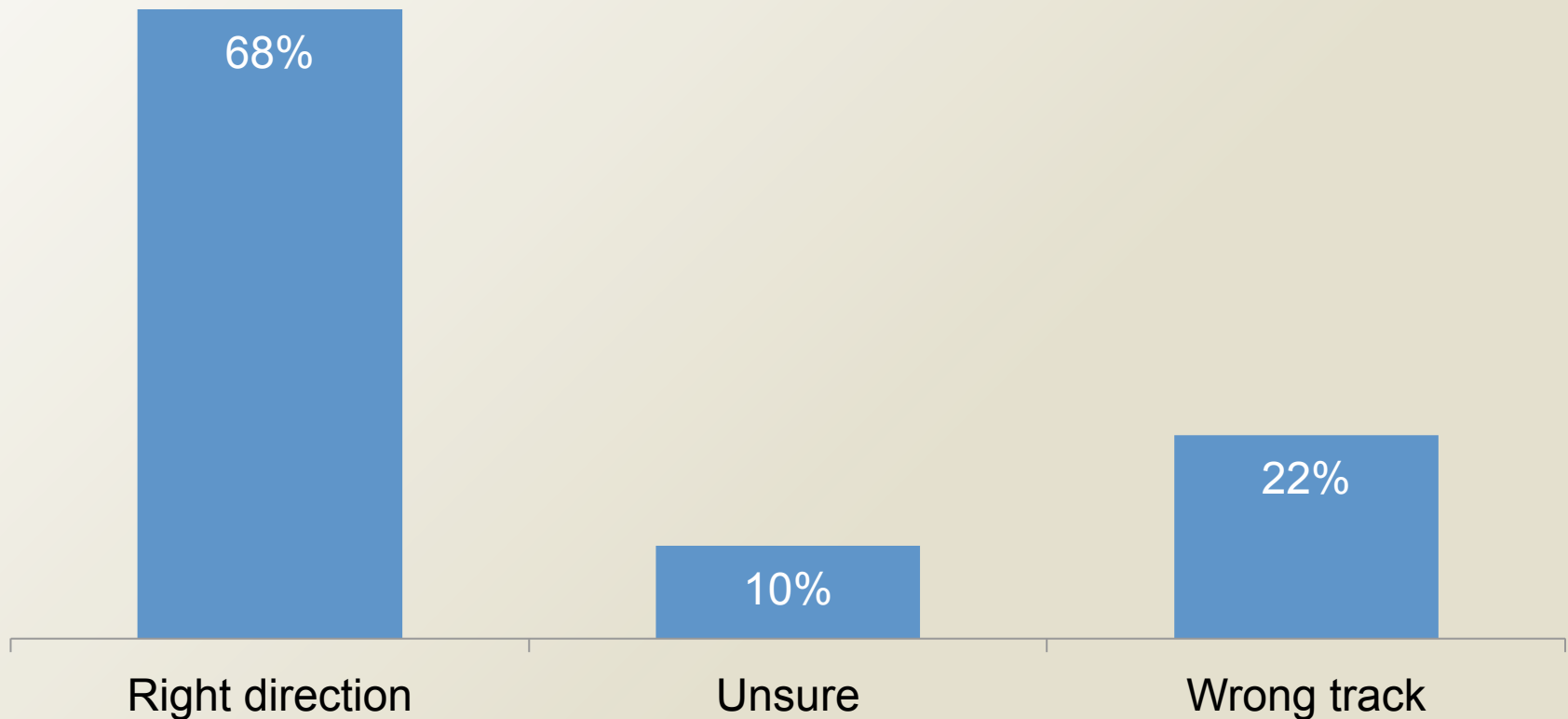

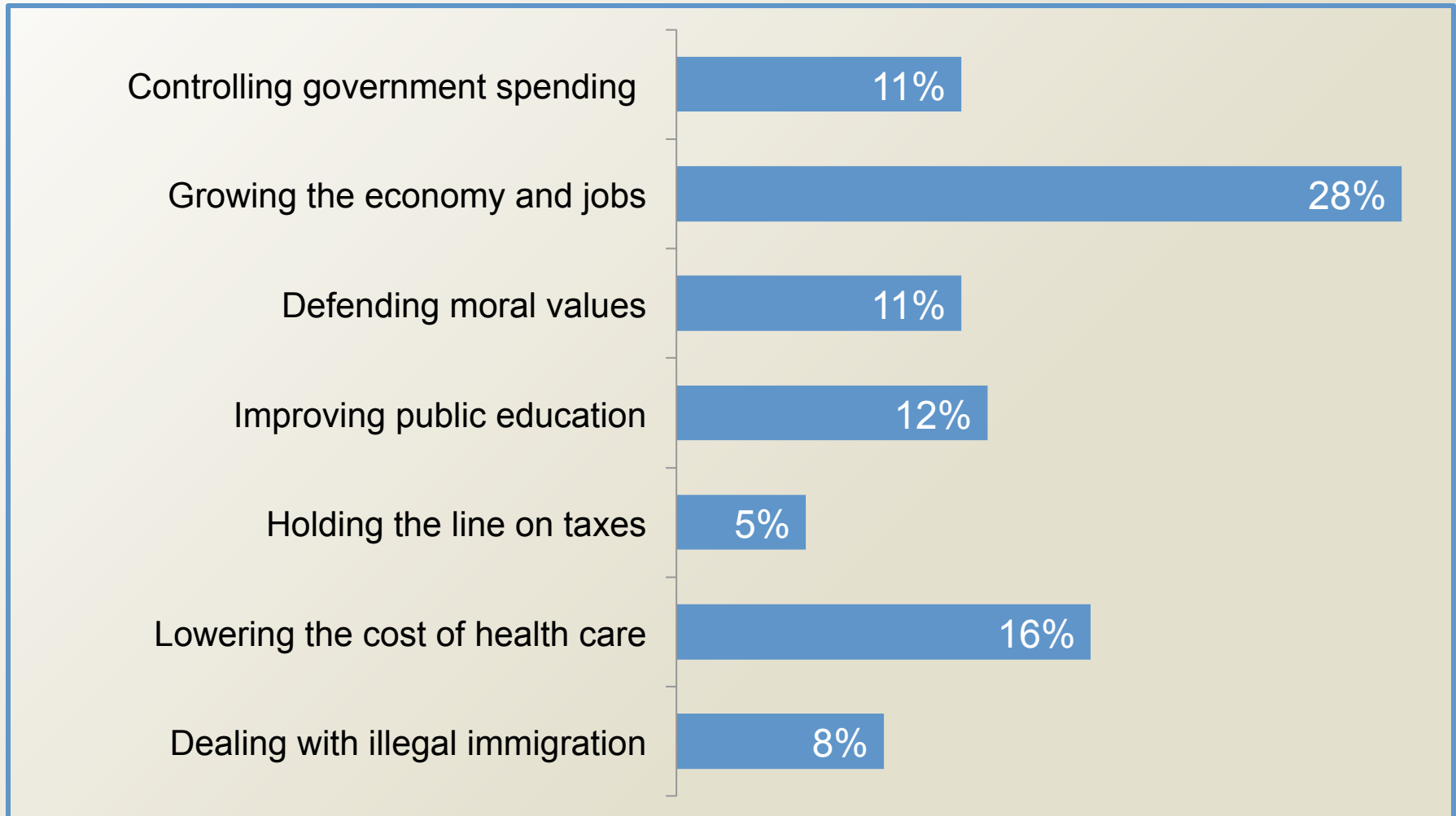

Do you feel things here in Ohio are going in the right direction, or do you feel things have gotten off on the wrong track?



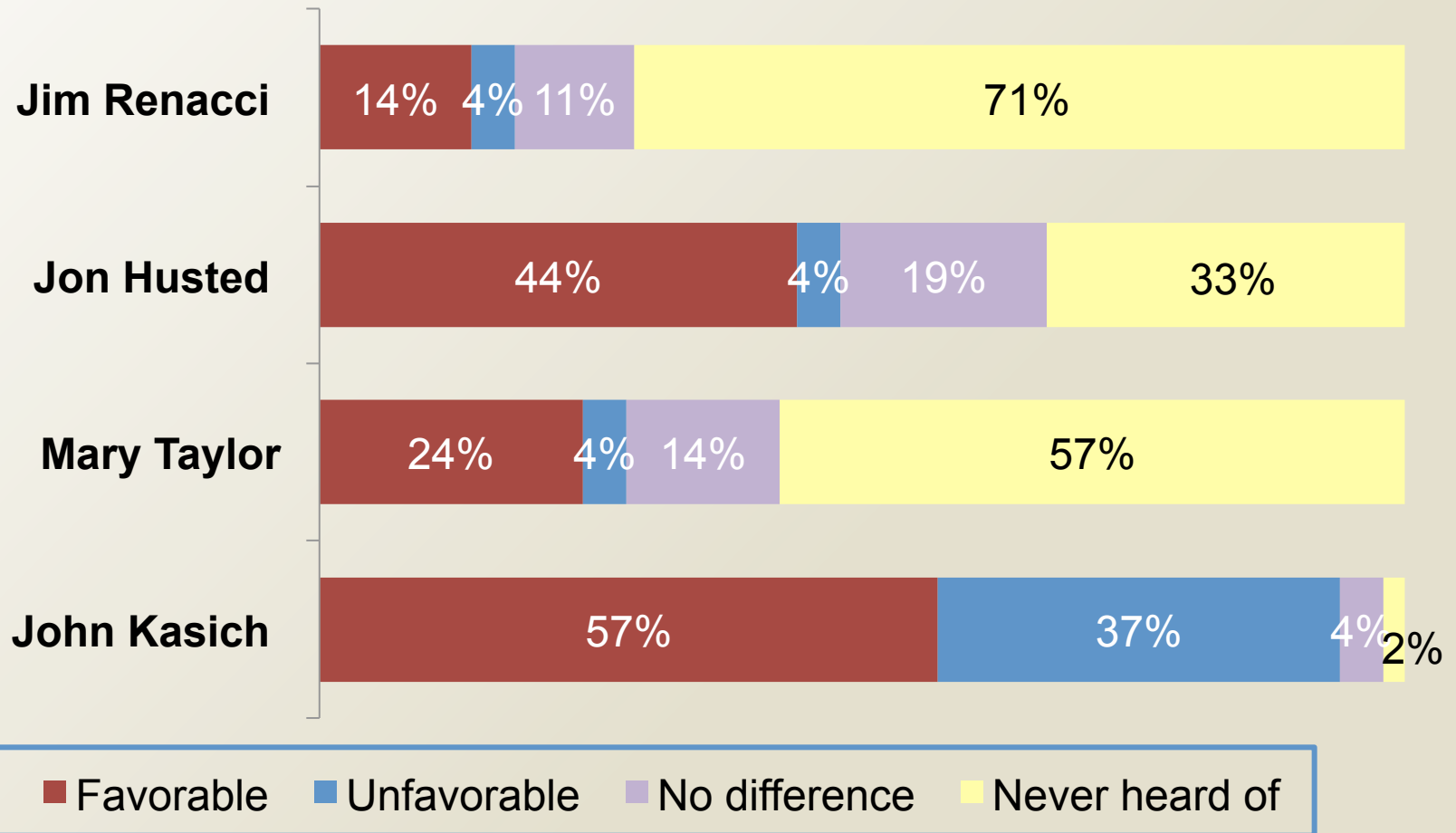

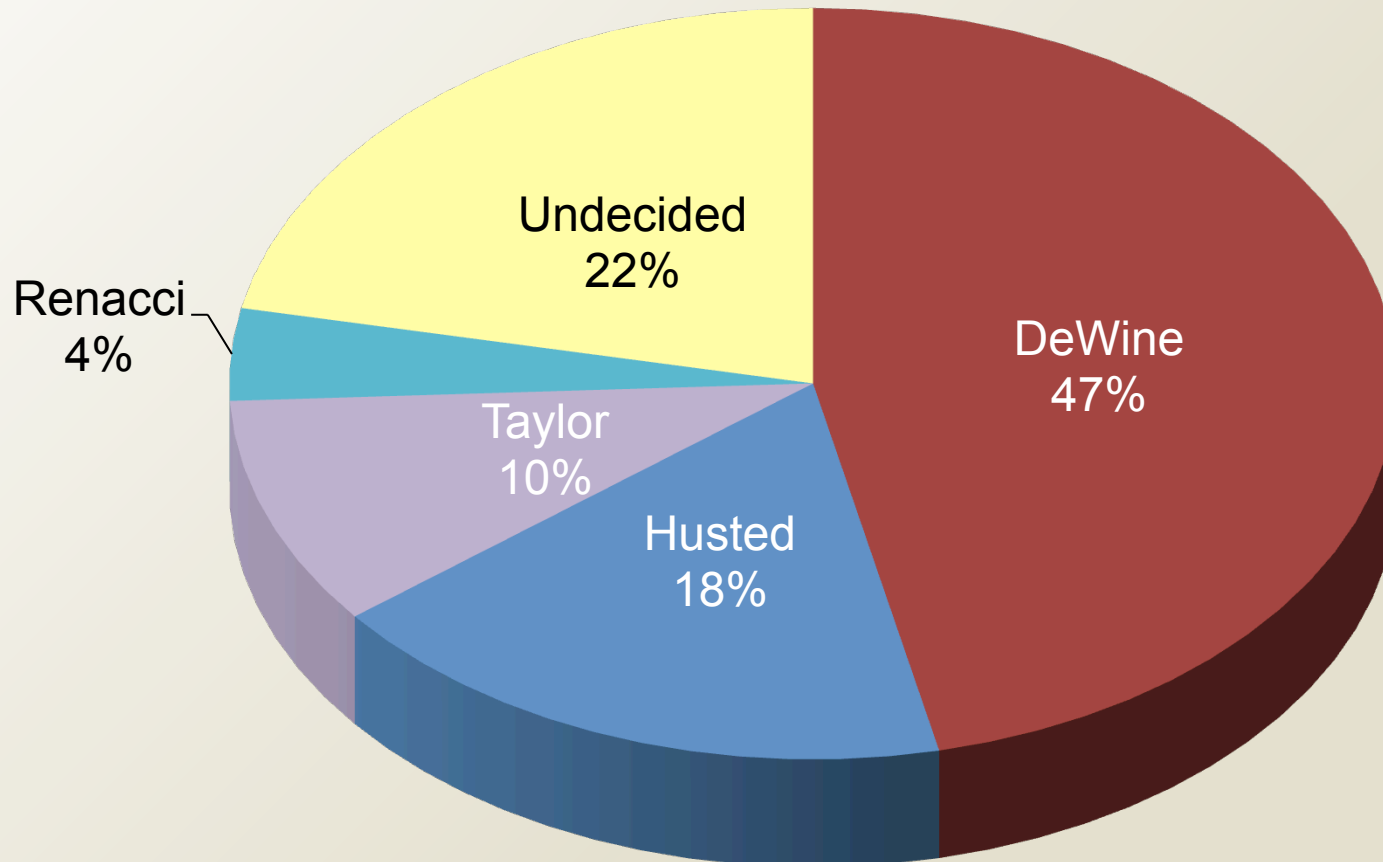
Do you think of Mike DeWine as a liberal, a moderate or a conservative?



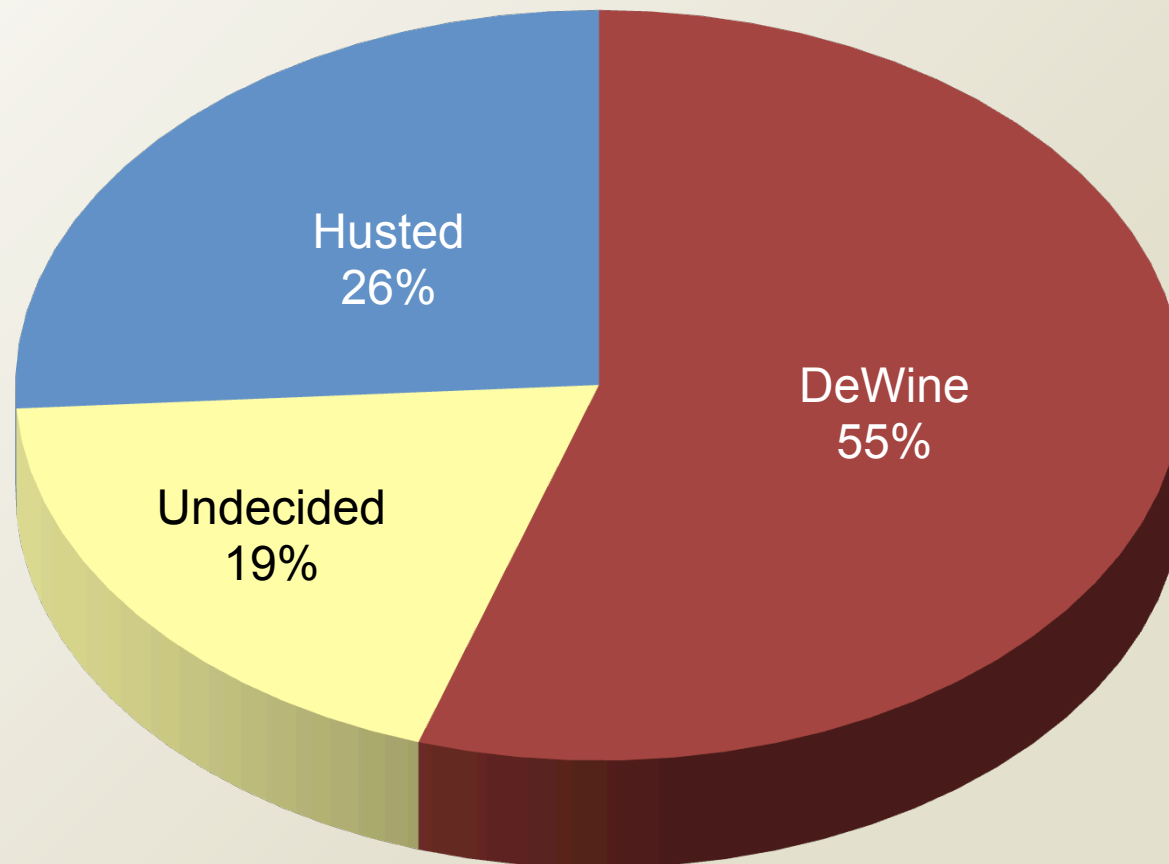

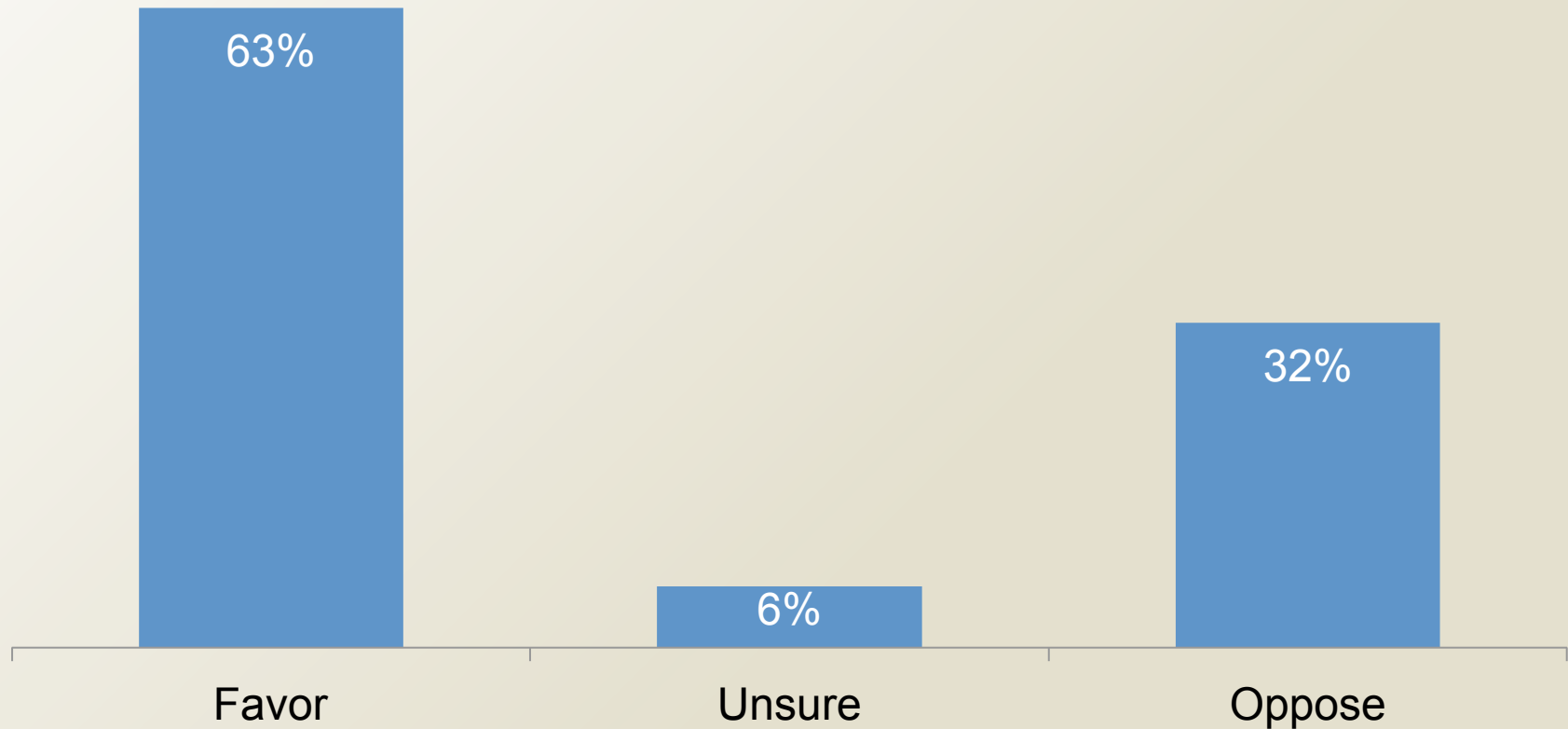

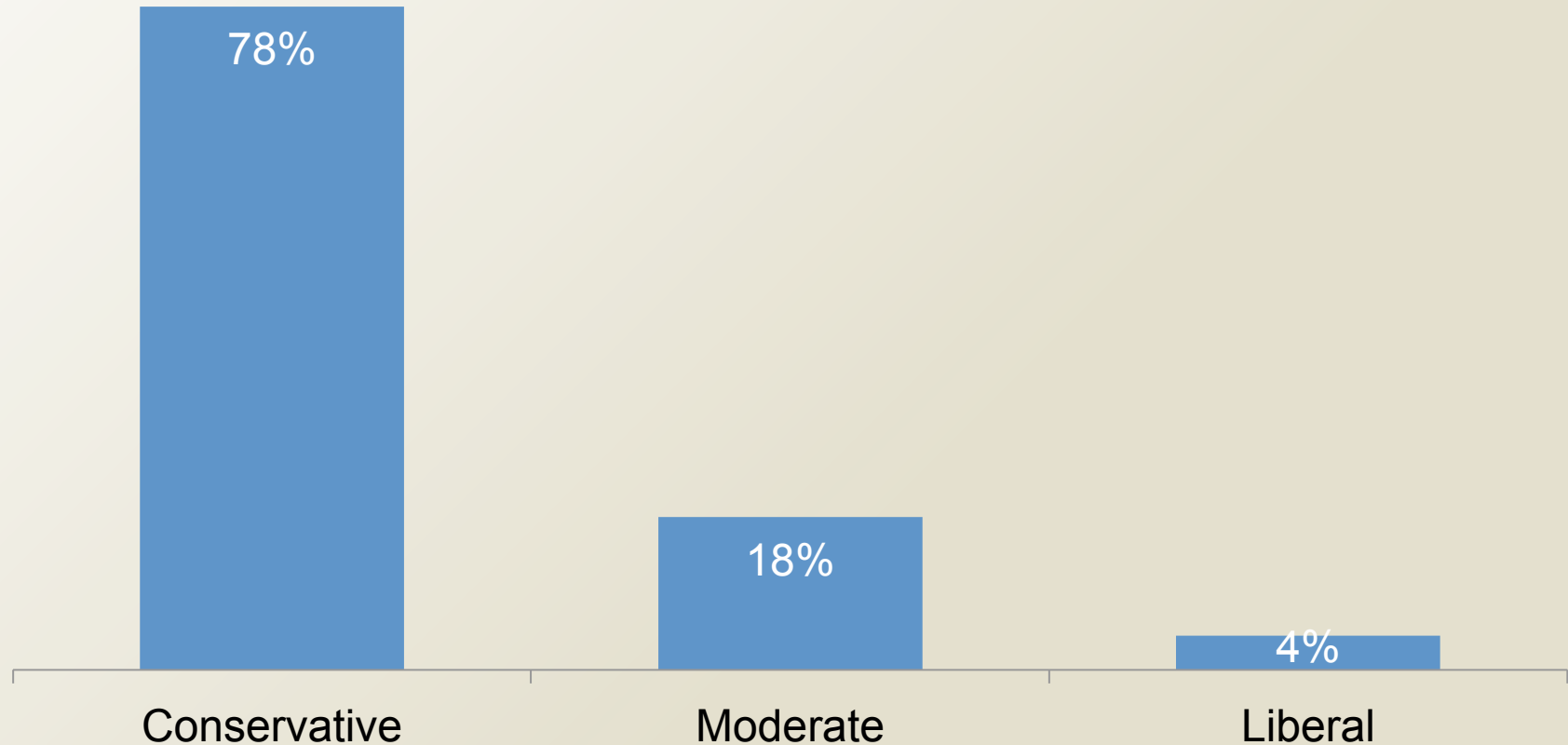
If the Republican primary election for Governor were held today and you had to make a choice, for whom would you vote...
Mike DeWine, or Jon Husted?



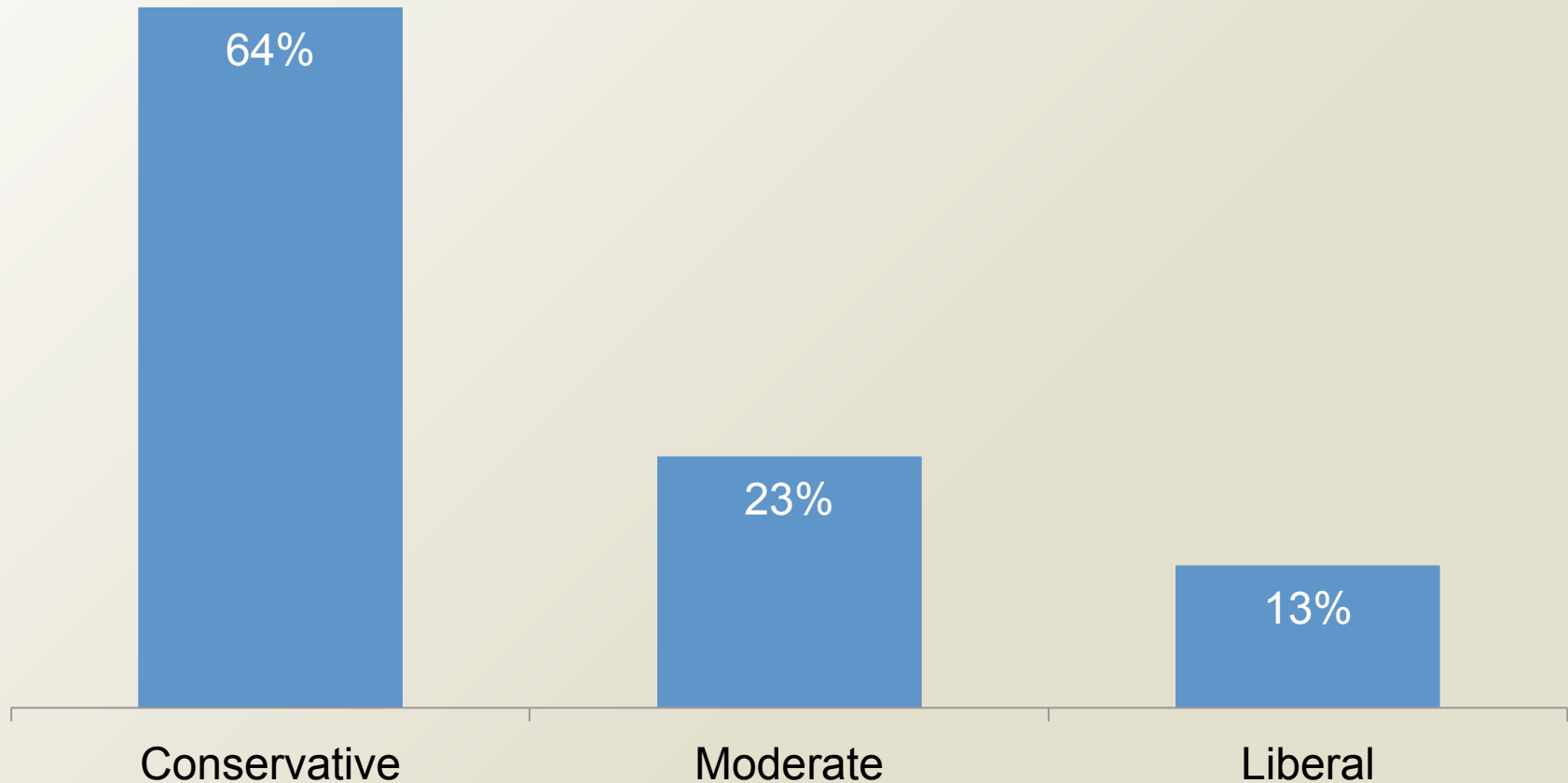
Would you favor or oppose using state funding for public education to allow parents to send their children to a school of their choice, even a private or religious school?



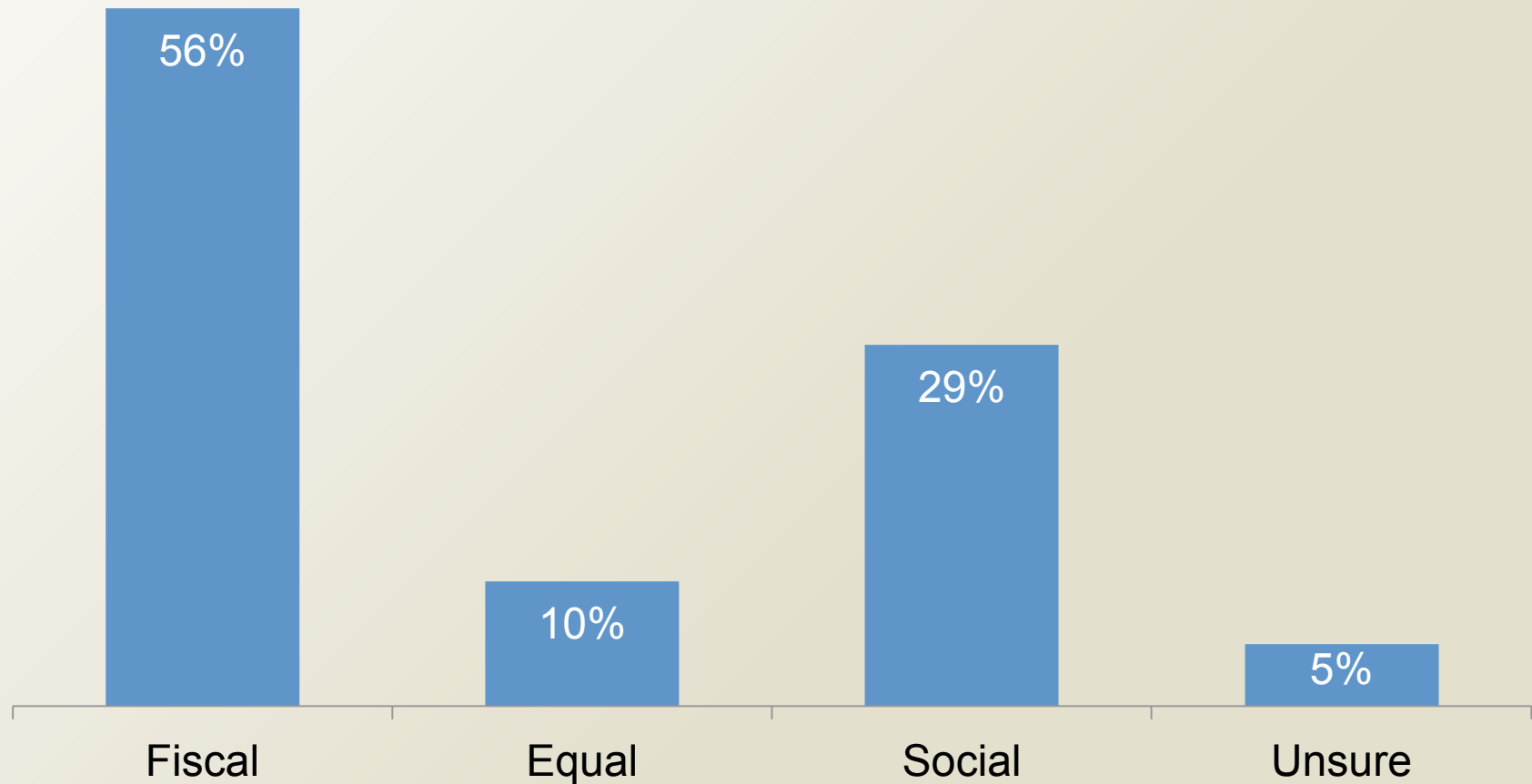
When thinking about your position on FISCAL issues, like taxes and spending, do you consider yourself to be...
