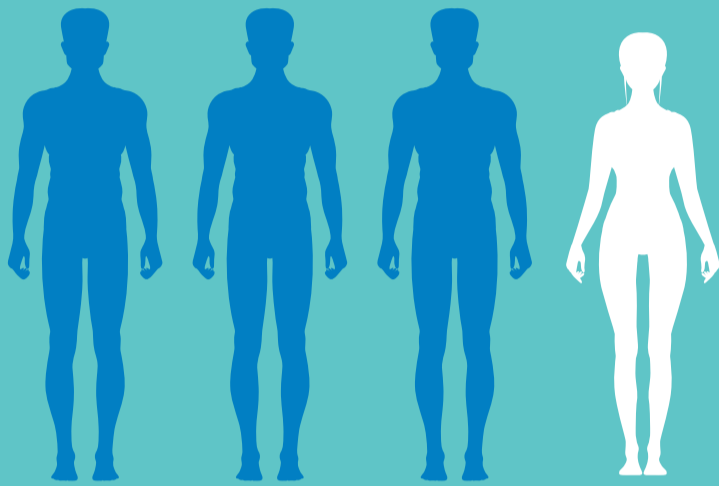

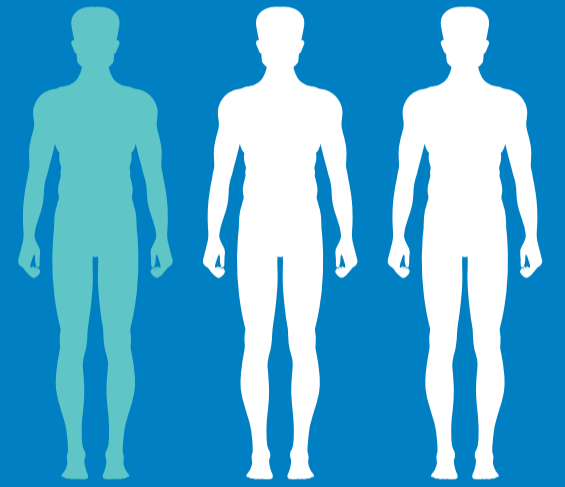

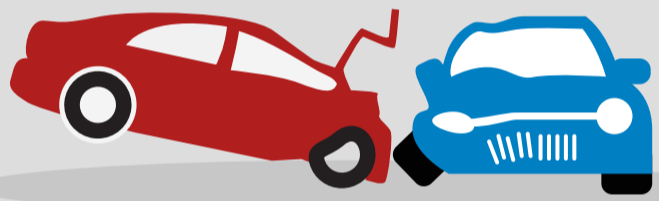


In 2017 there were 804 suicide deaths, 609 male and 195 female. (ABS)

There were 314 road deaths in 2017, 228 male and 86 female. (ABS)

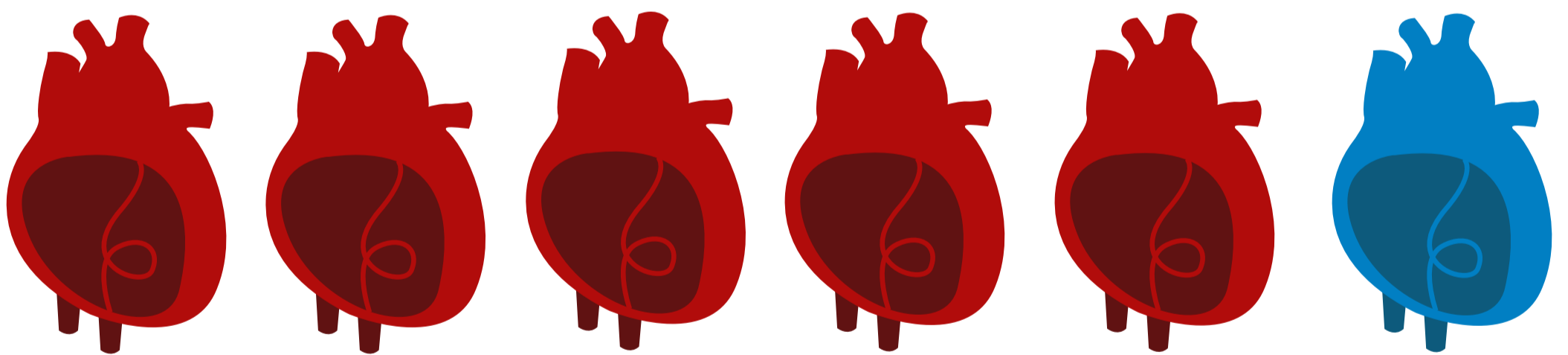

## **5 TIMES MORE MEN** DIE OF HEART DISEASE (Aged 45-54)

Coronary heart disease kills 6 men a day in QLD. 139 of the 166 people aged 45-54 who died of heart disease in 2017 were men. (ABS)

## **1 IN 5 BOYS** LIVE IN LONE PARENT FAMILIES



In 2011, 20.4% of children were living in one parent families. (ABS)
