s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

*Arrangement for conduct of election.*

[1] On 12 April 2019 the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union" known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers' Union (AMWU) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill various offices due to insufficient nominations received in a previous election (E2018/210) and casual vacancies for the remainder of the term.

[2] On 14 June 2019, the decision issued by the Delegate of the Registered Organisations Commissioner [[2019] ROCD 103] arranged for the election of the requested offices arising as a consequence of both insufficient nominations and casual vacancies.

[3] In the decision, the following office was listed as both requiring an election as a result of insufficient nominations and as a result of a casual vacancy. The election for this office is, in fact, only required as a consequence of a casual vacancy.

[4] Consequently the decision issued by the Delegate of the Registered Organisations Commissioner on 14 June 2019 [[2019] ROCD 103] is corrected as follows:

By deleting 'WA Branch – Women Delegate to State Conference' from the list of officers at paragraph [1].
