NOTICE OF PARTICULARS OF ALTERATIONS OF RULES

I, Paul Bastian, of 133 Parramatta Road, Granville, in the State of New South Wales, Union Official, give notice of the following matters in relation to the alterations of the Rules of the “Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union” known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers’ Union (AMWU).

1. I am the National Secretary of the AMWU, an organisation of employees registered under the *Fair Work Act 2009* (the Act).
2. I am authorised to give this notice of particulars of alterations to the Rules of the AMWU and to make declaration required by subregulation 126(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009.
3. The particulars of the alterations are attached in the documents marked “Schedule A”.
4. I declare that the alterations were made in accordance with the Rules of the AMWU. The actions taken under the Rules to make the alterations were as follows:
 - (a) On 26 August, 2019 a majority of members of National Council endorsed the alterations attached and resolved to refer the alterations to National Conference for determination.
 - (b) On 29 August, 2019, the proposed alteration was put to the in-session meeting of National Conference, where a majority of members of the National Conference endorsed the alteration. I note that National Conference has the power to amend the Rules of the Union pursuant to Rule 5A2(h) of the Union’s Rules.
 - (c) The National Conference resolution endorsing the alteration is attached in the document marked “Schedule B”.
5. I declare that the particulars of the alterations set out in this notice are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

SCHEDULE A

1. Delete the current Rule 6B.6.1(c) and replace with the following:

“From the certification of this Rule Change until 30 June, 2023, the Assistant State Secretary from the Print Membership Area in Victoria.”

2. Delete the current Rule 6B.6.4 and replace with the following:

“4. In the event that the office of Assistant State Secretary from the Print Membership Area in Victoria is abolished during the transitional period consistent with rule 5H3.2, the Additional Delegate to the National Council representing the Printing Membership Area shall be the Assistant State Secretary representing the Print Membership Area in NSW.”

SCHEDULE B

EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 2019 NATIONAL CONFERENCE

Conference endorses the proposal from the Print Membership Area to amend Rule 6B.6.1(c) such that the additional Delegate to National Council from the Print Membership Area for the entire Transitional Period shall be the Assistant State Secretary representing the Print Membership Area in Victoria.

Conference further notes the requirement for a subsequent amendment to Rule 6B.6.4.

Conference endorses the proposed Rule change as noted below and authorises the National Secretary to take steps to have the amendment certified as required.

1. Delete the current Rule 6B.6.1(c) and replace with the following:

“From the certification of this Rule Change until 30 June, 2023, the Assistant State Secretary from the Print Membership Area in Victoria.”

2. Delete the current Rule 6B.6.4 and replace with the following:

“4. In the event that the office of Assistant State Secretary from the Print Membership Area in Victoria is abolished during the transitional period consistent with rule 5H3.2, the Additional Delegate to the National Council representing the Printing Membership Area shall be the Assistant State Secretary representing the Print Membership Area in NSW.”
