

**NOTICE OF PARTICULARS OF ALTERATIONS OF RULES**

I, Paul Bastian, of 133 Parramatta Road, Granville, in the State of New South Wales, Union Official, give notice of the following matters in relation to the alterations of the Rules of the “Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union” known as the Australian Manufacturing Workers’ Union (AMWU).

1. I am the National Secretary of the AMWU, an organisation of employees registered under the *Fair Work Act 2009* (the Act).
2. I am authorised to give this notice of particulars of alterations to the Rules of the AMWU and to make declaration required by subregulation 126(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009.
3. The particulars of the alterations are attached in the documents marked “Schedule A”.
4. I declare that the alterations were made in accordance with the Rules of the AMWU. The actions taken under the Rules to make the alterations were as follows:
  - (a) On 17 March, 2020 a majority of members of National Council endorsed the alterations attached and resolved to refer the alterations to National Conference for determination, consistent with Rule 5A2.5(a).
  - (b) On 1 May, 2020, the proposed alteration was put to a ballot of National Conference Delegates. I note that National Conference has the power to amend the Rules of the Union pursuant to Rule 5A2(h) of the Union’s Rules.
  - (c) On 22 May, 2020, a majority of Delegates to National Conference endorsed the attached alteration marked “Schedule A”.
5. I declare that the particulars of the alterations set out in this notice are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

## SCHEDULE A

1. Delete the reference to Rule 6C.6 from Rule 6B.2(c).
2. Insert a new sentence at the end of existing Rule 6B.2(c) as follows:

*Elections at National Conference as required shall further be conducted consistent with the provisions of Rule 6C.6 except that a nominator must be a National Conference Delegate who is employed by the Union in one of those three States Branches with the fewest financial members as at the final day of the quarter immediately prior to the biennial meeting of the National Conference.*

3. Delete the second sentence of the existing rule 6C.13 and replace it with the following:

*Subject to a determination by the Returning Officer to extend the period, the ballot period shall be 45 minutes.*

4. Insert a new sentence at the end of current Rule 6C.22(a)(i) as follows:

*An application for an absentee ballot consistent with this rule must be received by the Returning Officer by 4pm on the day immediately preceding the Conference.*
