

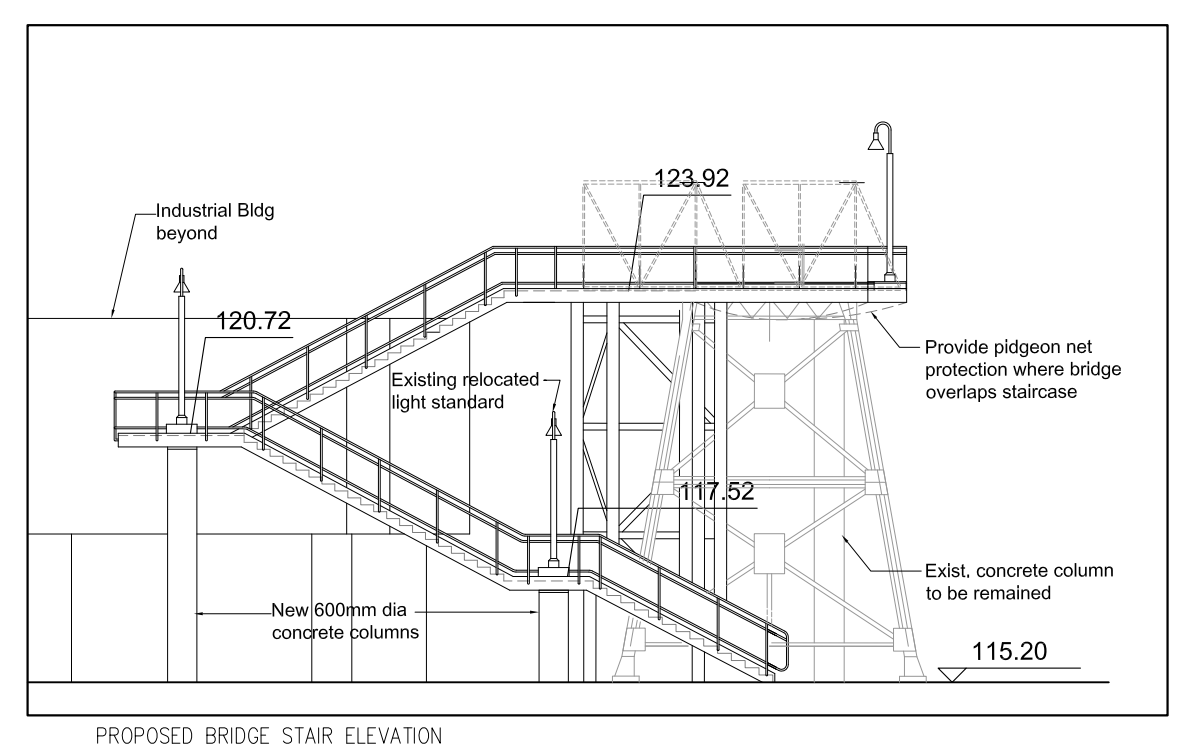
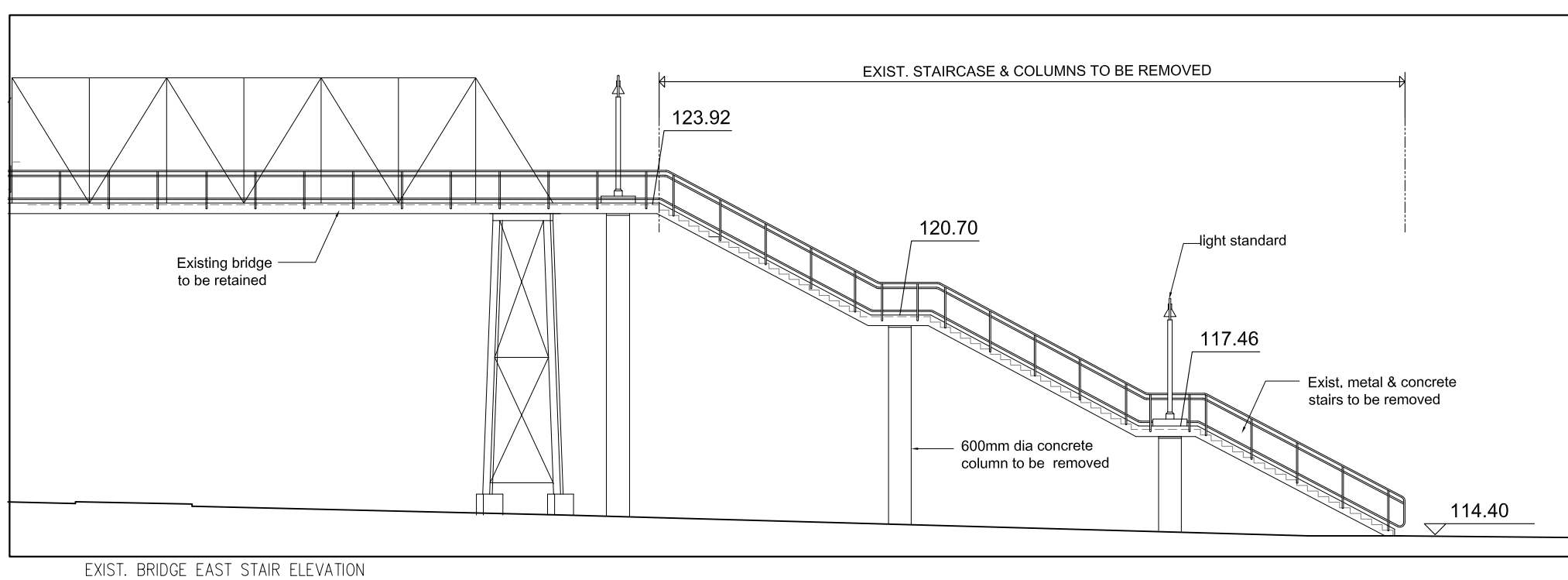

New Stair Installation Wallace Street Pedestrian Bridge

Closure Start Date: March 20, 2017

Closure End Date: March 28, 2017

The City of Toronto has approved Somerset Wallace Developments Inc.'s application to install new stairs on the pedestrian bridge at the terminus of Wallace Street. The stairs need to be realigned to accommodate construction of a mixed-use development at 362 Wallace Avenue, community centre, and the completion of Sousa Mendes Street.



Construction Details:

This project will involve:

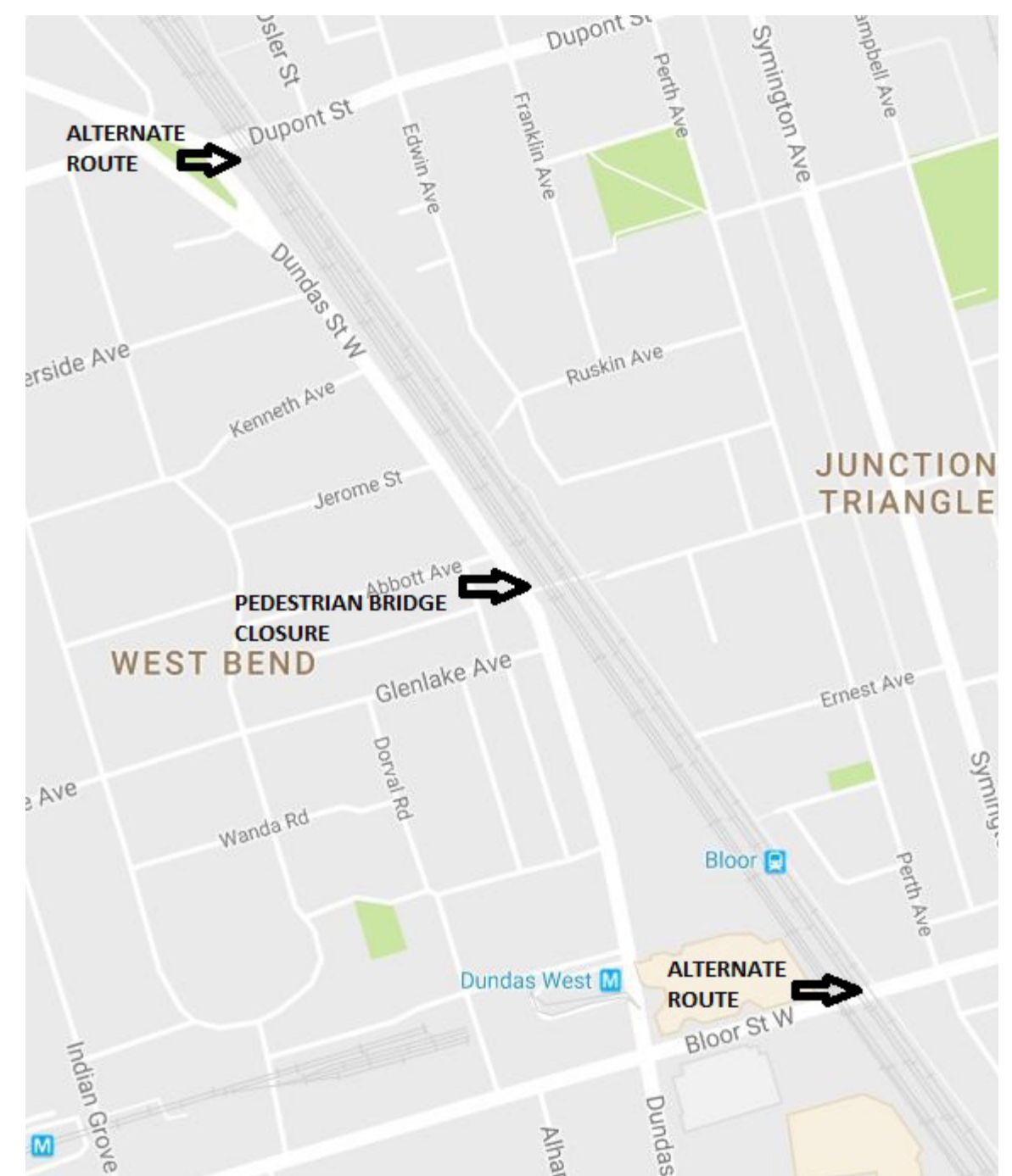
- Construction and testing of the new staircase
- Closure of the existing stair case and connection of the existing bridge to the new staircase
- Demolition of the existing stair case

Work Hours:

Work will typically take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Disruptions:

Residents can expect noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively there will be a **temporary closure of the stairs from March 20th to March 28th**. Please use an alternate route (Dupont Street or Bloor Street) for the dates the bridge is closed.
