You will also have the opportunity to have your monologue professionally recorded during the workshop which may be counted as your Video Submission in Round 1 of the competition.

You are encouraged to have rehearsed your monologue in advance to ensure you benefit as much as possible from the workshop, and to take full advantage of having your monologue professionally recorded on the day.

If you do not have your monologue recorded at the workshop, your own video recording for Round 1 should be submitted by 7 August 2020 as outlined in the competition brief.
