Dear Attorney Sparks,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for 45-year-old David Jackson, of Frankfort, Kentucky, to be punished for keeping dozens of pit bulls in cruel conditions. We garnered 10,492 signatures within ten days. The Franklin County Sheriff's Office described the pitiful conditions that 38 dogs were living in, writing:

The dogs were tied to stakes in the ground, trees, and other immovable objects with very large metal chains, one of which weighed approximately 42 pounds. The animals had been there for quite some time. Many of them did not have any clean water or food in their bowls and very little shelter from the elements.

It is our understanding that Jackson is facing multiple animal cruelty charges, and that more charges could be forthcoming. It is our hope that this man will receive the maximum jail sentence, and fines, for his actions. We further hope to see him prohibited from owning any animals in the future.
