Dear County Attorney Steve Gold:

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for the individual responsible for stealing and killing a poodle named Duke to be punished to the fullest extent of the law. It is our understanding that the authorities have identified 32-year-old Bryan Matthews as Duke's killer.

Over 13,000 people have signed our petition (see below) asking for Matthews to receive the maximum punishment allowed under law for the two Class D felonies resulting from the incident which claimed Duke's life.

A necropsy revealed that this innocent dog was burned alive. Matthews must face significant punishment for this horrific crime. We look forward to hearing back from you with the current status of this animal cruelty case. Thank you for your time and consideration.
